Appendix D: CCFRI Fee Limit Policy

Stakeholder Communications Approach (for ED and ADM information)

Updated: Dec 23, 2020

Context:

The Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative (CCFRI), launched in April 2018, provides funding to participating child care facilities to reduce their monthly parent fees by up to \$350 per enrolment. Providers seeking to participate in the CCFRI must apply each fiscal year and disclose any recent or proposed fee increases, which the Ministry reviews to ensure that they do not unreasonably dilute the intended fee reduction for families.

In its review of each facility's CCFRI application, the Ministry approves a recent or proposed fee increase if it is in line with the facility's historical fee increases. This can result in some facilities being approved for significant increases.

The Ministry also reviews whether the facility's fee increase is nominal, whether the facility's fees are below median for its region, and whether the facility is in an exceptional situation.

Currently, new facilities may establish their initial fees at any level, giving them a perceived advantage over existing CCFRI-enrolled facilities, whose fee increases need to be approved by the Ministry.

Fee Limits for New Facilities - launch April 2021

Under the "New Facilities Policy", New, New-to-CCFRI and Modified facilities will only be eligible to receive CCFRI if their fees are at or below the 70th percentile of the previous year's fees for their care type and Service Delivery Area (SDA), subject to limited exceptions.

For example, the following table shows the Kootenay regional 70th percentile fees. If this policy were effective in 2019/20, the new facility would be approved for CCFRI if its fees met or fell below these rates for the specified categories of care.

The effects of the policy are not retroactive, and do not impact facilities already approved for CCFRI. Facilities that have applied for space creation funding from any stream (New Spaces Fund, UBCM, Rapid Renovation Fund) prior to April 1, 2021 are exempt from this policy update.
