- Investigations and Quality of Care investigations are conducted within the PT where the child resides.
- PSIM does not track or house records of investigations or QoC audits for out of province matters.
- Interprovincial tracking began in early 2020
- Type of placement is not tracked centrally
- Totals are currently being tallied for end of December 2022 and are expected to be reconciled in early January 2023.
- IPPAs totals are manually reconciled on a bi-annual basis.
