on Friday & Saturday night from 2200-0500 hrs. wide its Omnibus decision of October -2012.

The Vancouver Taxi companies originally submitted their pilot project idea to the Passenger Transportation Board in 2015 and were denied in December, a few months ago. The Vancouver Taxi companies had applied for 198 licenses on a temporary basis from December 7-2015 to March 9-2015 for their proposed pilot project.

Instead the Passenger Transportation Board allowed 58 (Festive TOPS) licenses to operate temporarily over the holidays from December 10-2015 to January 8-2016. While the Vancouver Taxi Association is on record saying that 58 was not enough taxis, they activated 47 licenses and not for the full period. No plate was activated past December 31-2015. We feel that to move forward for the betterment of the customer experience and the industry, the taxi associations should work together within the exiting legislative framework until such time as Government either amend or repeals it.

The B.C., Taxi Association looks forward to meeting with you on Wednesday, March 16th to discuss further.
