Update on 2015/16 Budget

- In Dec 2014 TB approved funding for 14 new projects, and 6 approved in June.
- Approved projects fully utilize increased funding in 2015/16 and 2016/17.
- Ministries are improving their ability to plan and manage projects and we expect to reduce the over-approvals in future.




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IM/IT Capital Planning Overview

Planning approach

- Focus effort on important business issues
 - Concept Case quickly identifies business issue
 - Prioritize using criteria
 - DMCTT confirms business priorities
 - Ministries focus on business cases for priorities
- Work collaboratively and include experts in plans
 - In developing the business case ministries work with experts across government
 - Finance, HR, UX, Identity, Security, Architecture
 - Leverage corporate enablers in planning
 - Services Card, PayBC, Data, CAS, T&L



Assessment and Prioritization Criteria

- 1. DMCTT Criteria
- 2. Subject matter expert review
- 3. 36 technical assessment criteria
 - 1. Strategic
 - Economic
 - 3. Financial
 - 4. Commercial
 - 5. Management/capacity



DMCTT Prioritization Criteria (July 2015)

- Strategic priorities and government commitments
- Aligns with corporate enablers and strategic direction (Services Card, Cloud Strategy, Red Tape Reduction)
- Required by legislation
- Reduces government's operating costs or increases revenue
- Reduces red tape and improves service delivery Contributes to economic growth
- Addresses health and safety concerns

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
