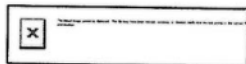

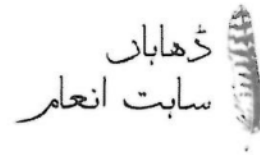
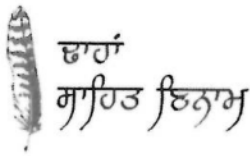

**Re: 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Dhahan Prize for Punjabi Literature – Saturday, November 4, 2017 at 6:30 pm – 9:00 pm**

We are writing to invite you to the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Dhahan Prize Awards Ceremony to be held this year on Saturday November 4<sup>th</sup> at the Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre, University of British Columbia (UBC).

The Dhahan Prize was founded in 2013 by Barj Dhahan, family and friends in partnership with UBC. The Prize itself inspires the creation of Punjabi literature across the world; encouraging new writing, bridging communities, and building diverse global understanding by awarding a \$25,000 prize to the winning Punjabi author and \$5,000 to the two finalists. It is the largest monetary literary prize in South Asia's indigenous languages and possibly the most prestigious in Punjabi literature. The 2016 Dhahan Prize winner was Toronto based Mr. Jarnail Singh for his short story collection "*Kaale Varke*" (Black Pages) along with finalists Simran Dhaliwal (India) and Zahid Hassan (Pakistan).

The Prize is awarded by the Canada-India Education Society (CIES), a registered Canadian non-profit organization whose mission is to connect people and transform communities in Canada and India.

We believe that the values and principles of The Prize align very closely with the Canadian values of celebrating diversity by promoting cultural understanding and creating lasting social impacts. The Prize is a unique platform connecting people of Indo-Pakistani origin with other Canadians and celebrating the presence of Punjabi in British Columbia and Canada for over a century.

Canadian Punjabi speakers number nearly 500,000 people and account for roughly 1.5 % of Canada's population. The following are interesting facts about Punjabi:

- Punjabi is the tenth most widely spoken language in the world
- Punjabi has been spoken in British Columbia for over 120 years
- In British Columbia, Punjabi is the third most spoken first language, after English and Chinese
- In Canada Punjabi is the fourth most commonly spoken language
- In Metro Vancouver, 17.7% of all immigrant language speakers speak Punjabi at home
- In India, speakers of Punjabi comprise 1.72 % of the population



- In Pakistan nearly 60 % of the people speak Punjabi
- Punjabi has strong advocates and literary communities today in Canada, USA, UK, India, Pakistan and Singapore
- Preservation of the Punjabi language is a major concern with Punjabis
- Punjabi language courses are currently offered in elementary and high schools and universities in British Columbia
- Proficiency in Punjabi language is a growing in demand marketplace skill in British Columbia, Canada and elsewhere

Earlier this year, the Dhahan Prize established a creative writing Youth Award in partnership with Coast Capital Savings Credit Union and L.A. Matheson High School, Surrey for grade 11 and 12 students taking Punjabi language courses in British Columbia secondary schools. Eight Youth Awards of \$ 500 each will be awarded for original short stories written in Punjabi along with English translation by the authors. The Youth Award provides an opportunity for greater acceptance of the language as a vehicle of communication bringing together native speakers of the language and non-Punjabi speakers in high schools throughout the province. The Youth Award is being presented as a method for establishing a platform so they will continue to foster their creativity in hopes that they will be the next generation publishing full length novels to continue the preservation of the language and tell their stories.

We are excited and honoured to have Mr. Khelsilem deliver the keynote address (past keynotes are renowned Punjabi writer and critic Mr. Waryam Singh Sandhu and award winning authors Shauna Singh Baldwin and MG Vassanji ) at the Dhahan Prize ceremony where both the winners of the main Prize and the Youth Award will be recognized. Khelsilem is a young educator and community organizer. He is both Squamish and Kwakwaka'wakw - living in Vancouver, BC. He is the founder of the Squamish language program at Simon Fraser University and serves as the Skwxwú7mesh-Kwakwaka'wakw (N̓amgis' and Kwikw̓as̓tinuxw) programming director He is also founder of Kwi Awt Stelmexw a platform for arts and education. His passion is creating opportunities for growth, renewal, and exploration for Indigenous peoples. He founded Kwi Awt Stelmexw to help accomplish that with his people.

The Dhahan Prize calls attention to significant ongoing cultural production across national boundaries, encourages new writing, and acts as both recognition and incentive for the Punjabi literary community around the world. The Dhahan Prize provides a unique platform to connect people of Indo-Pakistani heritage not only in British Columbia but also around the world while supporting greater cultural understanding in Canada's diversity.

We are also requesting the Province of British Columbia to proclaim Nov. 4 to 11 as the Punjabi Literature Week in British Columbia as was proclaimed in 2016. Please find attached 2016 Proclamation for your reference. It would be wonderful to have both of you join us in this much anticipated celebration and to declare the proclamation in person.
