



Background/Facts:


- The Province is building a new Law Courts facility in the Abbotsford Civic Precinct to address
 priorities outlined in the Ministry of Justice's Lower Fraser Valley Regional Courts Plan to improve
 access to justice for citizens in this fast-growing region. This Project aligns with the
 Government's published three key commitments to British Columbians:
 - To make life more affordable: Currently, justice services are spread out around the area, creating challenges and expense for some citizens who need to access these services across disparate locations. The Project will consolidate justice services in one facility.
 - To deliver services that people count on. The Project will improve access to justice by providing 14 more courtrooms as part of a larger strategy to reduce court backlogs driven by insufficient available courtrooms. Also, a Justice Access Centre is being established in the new facility to make it easier for citizens to obtain services related to non-criminal matters
 - To build a strong, sustainable, innovative economy that works for everyone. The Project will provide construction jobs, as well as an opportunity to modernize Justice services by including technology infrastructure to facilitate existing and emerging trends in courts technology.
- The potential for future expansion is a requirement of the project design.
- In January 2017, Treasury Board approved the \$157.2 million Project using a Design-Build-Finance-Maintain (DBFM) procurement model for the following reasons:

 Three teams are currently competing to design, build, partly finance and maintain the facility for the next 30 years, with the operations and maintenance agreement concluding in 2051.
 Construction is projected to start in late 2018 and complete in the fall of 2020. Court operations are expected to begin in early 2021.


