Hi Jennifer,

Do you know if the Haida Gwaii hospitals may be able to switch from using the overhead Telus fibre-optic line to the underground one that GwaiiTel had installed last year?

Some of our readers were surprised to learn the south-end hospital relies on the Telus line — the line was cut a couple of weeks ago when a vehicle hit a power pole in Tlell. The resulting outage left the south-end hospital and health centre without internet or regular phone service for several hours (they use a VOIP phone system).

My understanding is that the province signed a 10-year contract for a suite of telecom services with Telus in 2011, but that it is not exclusive.
