From the information you have provided, I have determined there to be minimal risk of data compromise as the device was powered off and you did not have your IDIR password written down and stored with it. As such, I will proceed to close this file.

As I mentioned before, please ensure that the GILR you completed is emailed to Governmentsecurityoffice@gov.bc.ca or faxed to **250-356-6222**. This ensures that the Government Security Office is aware of its theft. You also mentioned that you later became aware that your ID pass had been stolen. It is your responsibility to advise the Leg Security of this.

In closing, I would like to remind you that storing any asset in an unattended vehicle for any length of time is not recommended.

Hello Sheryl,
Still having problems in logging on for online reporting of the laptop.
However, let me answer the questions raised by you.
I realized the laptop was missing on Tuesday morning, Oct. 31st.
I had placed the laptop case in the trunk of my vehicle on Monday,
Oct.30. as I was visiting a few places and I did not want it to be visible.
was there any indication that your vehicle had been broken into?

There was no obvious sign of a break in. I am just not sure if the trunk was locked or not.

The Laptop was not logged on and I do not think it would have been powered on either.

I don't think the IDIR number or the password was in the laptop case. You "don't think" that password was in the laptop case; are you in the practice of sometimes writing down the password? Is there a chance that the password was written down and stored with the laptop?

I don't write the passwords anywhere, the IDIR was on a printed email but I fortunately had taken out these hard copy documents from the laptop case and put them in a binder which I use and that is in my possession. Just realized, my leg Photo Id was in the laptop case. Oops. The leg security needs to be notified also

The computer number is IM414002 This is not a computer number but instead the ticket number reporting its loss.

I do not know the computer number.

I will try to make the online report again, if unable, will contact you. Thanks. I have attached a printable version which you can complete and fax or email to the contact information at the top of the form.
