In past months, we have met with your colleagues in Caucus, along with key Ministers and their staff at both the political and departmental levels. We are also advancing this important project with the federal government and the City of Vancouver. The project has been well received by elected officials and staff at both levels.

By way of background, the Creative Energy Fuel Switch project aligns with the provincial government's commitments to invest in reducing GHGs and positioning British Columbia as an international leader in climate action. The Fuel Switch offers a unique and historic opportunity for British Columbia to reduce GHG emissions by 75% for heating more than 200 buildings through a single project – the equivalent to taking 14,000 cars off the road. This is one of the least costly sources of large GHG reductions in the building sector, and considerably less costly than current federal and provincial incentives for electric vehicles.

Creative Energy is one of the largest district energy companies in Canada. Our system in downtown Vancouver currently serves over 200 buildings and is regulated by the BCUC. The system serves many iconic buildings, including several provincial facilities such as BC Place and most notably St. Paul's Hospital, which Creative has served with over 99.99% reliability for nearly 50 years.
