



# Energy and Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Targets



Provincial reduction targets are measured compared to 2007:

- 40% by 2030
  - CleanBC raised target to 50% by 2030 (over 2010)
- 60% by 2040
- 80% by 2050

## Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

- CleanBC Goal: Light Duty Vehicle sales must be zero emissions vehicles:
  - 2025 = 10%
  - 2030 = 30%
  - 2040 = 100%
- EV charging infrastructure across portfolio:
  - Employee/visitors to government buildings
  - Fleet vehicles

# Challenges and Mitigation Strategies

 Impacts of COVID-19 and new service provider contract on project implementation



 Focus on GHG reductions over 2-3 years, rather than on an annual basis

 Uncertainty of climate change and requirement to include projects related to Adaptation



 Maintain a flexible program structure that can scale to the budget/program needs

Reporting methodology changes



 Maintain focus on reduction of emissions
