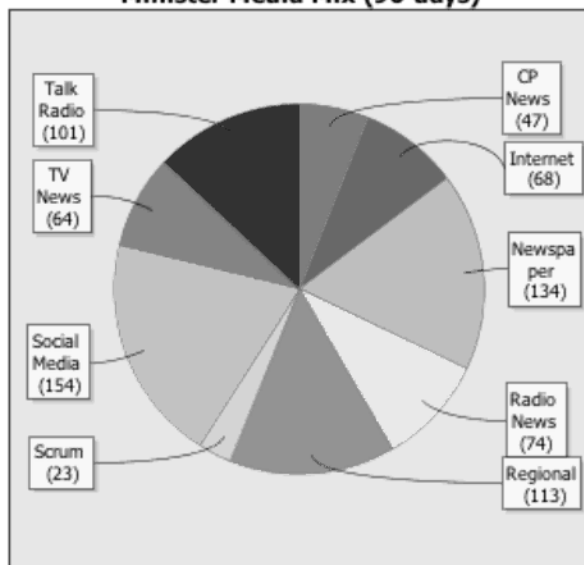

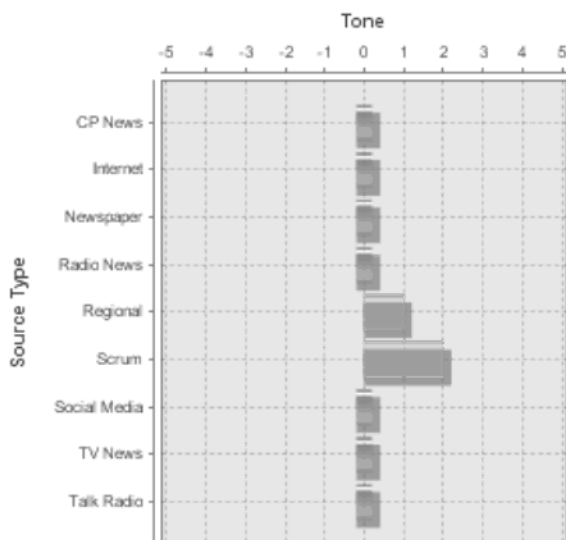

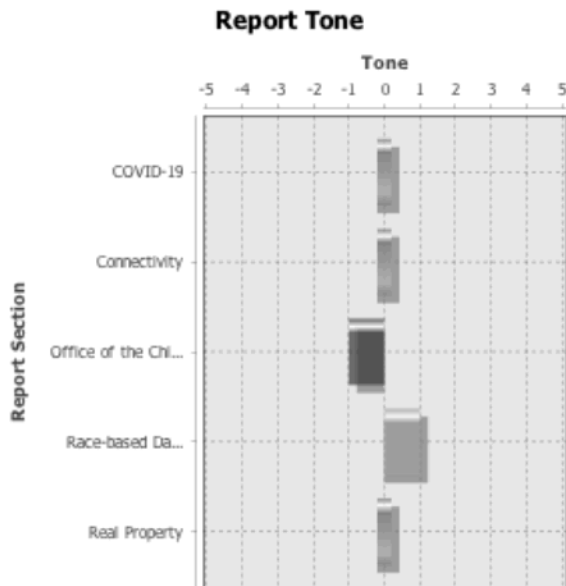

FYI.

- ISED has directed the large telecom companies to take immediate action to improve the resiliency and reliability of our networks and to establish the arrangement within 60 days.
  - Negotiate 'mutual assistance' agreements during outages
  - Institute emergency roaming on each other's networks
  - Establish a communications protocol 'to better inform the public and authorities during telecommunications emergencies'
- The Rogers outage would be investigated by the CRTC.
