#### TERMS OF REFERENCE

## PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY EXPECTED RESULTS FOR 2014/15 FISCAL YEAR

#### Introduction

The Minister of Education, Peter Fassbender (the Minister) is the lead on a number of initiatives as directed by Premier Christy Clark. Simon Gibson has been appointed the *Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education* to support these priorities with a specific focus on Independent Schools.

#### **Purpose and Authority**

The *Parliamentary Secretary* will support the Minister in achieving the outcomes outlined in BC's Education Plan, directed to ensure parents and students receive the support they need for strong student performance in our independent schools. The *Parliamentary Secretary* will be authorized by the Minister to act as his agent, working under his authority and direction.

#### **Duties**

As Parliamentary Secretary for Independent Schools, your duties include:

- 1. Building relationships with independent school s and promoting government support for choice while obtaining information to meet deliverables.
- 2. Participating in meetings and linking ongoing public engagement to personalized learning initiatives and B.C.'s Skills for Jobs Blueprint.
- 3. Working with the Minister of Education to determine any new priorities.

#### Deliverables for school year 2014/2015 are:

- Assist the Minister in reviewing the effectiveness of ACE-IT and apprenticeship training
  opportunities for students in British Columbia. Specifically, present to the Minister a report on
  independent school student access to dual credit, ACE-IT and apprenticeship training by
  April 30, 2015. Your report should include addressing actual or perceived barriers to independent
  school student access to these programs as well as opportunities to improve access for
  independent school students.
- In concert with the independents school sector and the Ministry of education, develop an
  engagement plan outlining how the parliamentary secretary will engage with independent
  schools. The engagement plan should encompass one year of engagement activities and be
  presented to the Minster of Education by June 30, 2014.

3. Assist the Minister in education reform as outlined in the BCED Plan. Specifically, produce a report for the Minister of Education on diversity within independent school student populations by October 31, 2015. This report should include challenges schools faced within the current reporting and program delivery framework and opportunities to consider for the future and address the proportion of students with learning disabilities which may not be accounted for or reported within the current special needs reporting framework

### Support

The *Parliamentary Secretary* will be supported through an active relationship with specified Ministry of Education staff. All expenditures and resourcing will be authorized through the Minister.
