Dear Mr. Bernier,

Vancouver District Parent Advisory Council is the elected voice for the parents and guardians of children in the Vancouver school district.

We are grateful to take up the call from parents to respond to the open letter you published yesterday about recent events regarding the Vancouver School Board, the Vancouver Board of Education, and the Ministry of Education. This letter closes with our second invitation to you to engage in person with Vancouver parents.

Parents in Vancouver are indeed concerned about the events unfolding in our school district. The VSB carried perhaps too big a burden this past year after having to cut planning staff in previous budgets:

The VSB completed the massive effort behind its Long Range Facilities Report which was premised on achieving your Ministry's 95% capacity utilization target. Vancouver DPAC did not agree with that target and we were pleased to see it rescinded.

The VSB further prepared a budget that, for the first time, contained cuts designated as Level 3 ("Impacts Large Numbers of Students") and Level 4 ("Severe Impacts on Teaching and Learning") which parents were told during the budget consultation would indeed be felt in the classroom. And despite the rejection of the proposed budget by VBE Trustees in April, the VSB was still required by the School Act to institute these deep, classroom-affecting cuts. Students in our district have been negatively impacted by these cuts, and we are deeply concerned about the long-term quality of our public education as a result of thirteen years of cuts.

The VSB and VBE have worked towards their next 5-year Strategic Plan which has required a great deal of time by VSB staff and senior management.

And the VSB and VBE have further worked above and beyond to meet with the Special Advisor and provide him the information and documentation that he has needed to complete his work, while at the same time working on a separate audit by the Auditor General.

We understand that these tasks have been very taxing on VSB staff and have taken their toil. We understand that at least 6 members of the senior staff are on medical leave. We understand that the BCSSA has written a letter to you describing some of the stress and impacts and requesting your assistance.

The complaints of a toxic work environment and bullying at the VSB are unsettling to say the least, and the lack of public evidence makes it difficult to discern the truth. Are we to believe the claims that Trustees are the ones doing the bullying? Or are we to believe the claims that the Special Advisor is the one who drove VSB staff to take stress leave? Or is the situation sufficiently complex that simple finger pointing and blame shifting by individuals supposedly in the know is making things worse rather than better? At this point, the investigation by WorkSafe BC will find answers to these questions. Suffice it to say that this is a deeply troubling situation for parents and children, knowing that several senior staff have had to take medical leave all at once, at this critical time.

What parents have discerned through all this — and from which we will not be distracted — is that children and youth have had many valuable programs cut. We are feeling the serious impacts of the cuts made a few months ago. Children and youth are going without the programming they need. As parents, we are deeply concerned about this.

What would provide stability for parents and school boards alike is for you and your government to reverse the chronic underfunding of public education in this province. We need legislation that enshrines stable, predictable, and sufficient funding for public education based on a model that puts student, family, and community needs first and which provides educators and administrators with the staff, supplies, and facilities to meet those needs.

As well, we want to see the Seismic Mitigation Program focused on building schools that will not just minimally survive The Big One but which will be available to provide continuity in the aftermath. This is as much a public safety issue as it is an educational issue.

These are things that keep parents in Vancouver and around the province up at night.

We would like to close by once again offering to host you in a democratic, non-partisan forum to engage with parents in the Vancouver school district. Thank you for taking the time to write to parents. We are pleased to be in dialog with you and hope that the outcome of our dialog will result in stability of funding and resourcing for the students of BC's public schools.

"WorkSafeBC is aware of a letter from the BC School Superintendents Association regarding the Vancouver School Board. WorkSafeBC will be proceeding with an investigation under the authority of the Workers Compensation Act. The Act provides the authority for WorkSafeBC to hold employers accountable for managing the health and safety of their workplaces, including for bullying and harassment. Pertinent background information is as follows:

What is bullying and harassment?

A worker is bullied and harassed when someone takes an action that he or she knew or reasonably ought to have known would cause that worker to be humiliated or intimidated. Bullying and harassment may occur between co-workers or between an employer and a worker or workers, or from external sources. It can also occur through email, text messages, social networks and other websites.

When an employer or supervisor takes reasonable action to manage and direct workers, it is not bullying and harassment.

Employers have an obligation to take reasonable steps to prevent bullying and harassment, or minimize it, where possible. Employers must develop a policy statement that addresses bullying and harassment in the workplace, develop and implement procedures for reporting incidents or complaints and for how they will be dealt with. They also have to train supervisors and workers, who are required to comply with policies and procedures and not engage in bullying and harassment. Workers must report it when they see it or experience it.

WorkSafeBC Prevention Officers inspect workplaces to determine if employers have taken reasonable steps to prevent and address bullying and harassment. WorkSafeBC has extensive resources on the matter of bullying and harassment on its website at WorkSafeBC.com."

"It's back," he said. "This isn't the first time the choking game has cycled through schools in B.C. Where we're seeing incidences of it, principals are meeting with parents, and meeting with kids. In some cases, counsellors and others are involved to make sure the parents are aware of the gravity of the situation, of how dangerous it is."

Allen said this time, Grade 6s and Grade 7s are involved but the response to timely intervention by the district seems to be working.

"In the two schools where we've seen it, that has pretty much put an end to it, although, of course, they can still read about it on the Internet," Allen said.

There is a difference between bullying and harassment and other types of incidents that can happen in the work environment. The following behaviours may not be bullying and harassment if they are approached in an appropriate manner:

- Expressing differences of opinion
- Offering constructive feedback, guidance, or advice about work-related behaviour and performance
- Making a legitimate complaint about someone's conduct through established procedures

Bullying and harassment should not be confused with a manager or supervisor exercising authority as part of his or her job. Examples of reasonable management action might include decisions relating to a worker's duties, workloads, deadlines, transfers, reorganizations, work instructions or feedback, work evaluation, performance management, or disciplinary actions.

Procedures for handling complaints

Employers must establish procedures stating how they will deal with bullying and harassment incidents and complaints in the workplace. Procedures must: ensure a reasonable response, aim to fully address the incident, and ensure future bullying and harassment is prevented or minimized.

Procedures must address the following:

- How and when investigations will be conducted
- What will be included in the investigation
- The roles and responsibilities of employers, supervisors, workers, and others (such as investigators, witnesses, or union representatives)
- Follow-up to the investigation (description of corrective actions, time frame, dealing with adverse symptoms, etc.)
- Record-keeping requirements

In addition to establishing procedures, employers are responsible for ensuring they are followed.

Workers are expected to cooperate with investigators and provide any details of acts of bullying or harassment they have experienced or witnessed.
