Thanks to your crucial, multifaceted support, youth across the province are empowered to become active local and global citizens, taking their place as the next generation of change-makers.

Your generous support allows We Act to remain a free and accessible resource to 870 schools across British Columbia. Furthermore, your support allowed us to welcome 18,000 deserving students from over 650 schools to We Day Vancouver last fall. The home of the Vancouver Canucks became the greatest classroom in the world where together celebrated local and global service as together we tackle issues ranging from bullying to protecting the environment.
