They understand that their individual conduct contributes to the perception of the profession as a whole. Educators are accountable for their conduct while on duty, as well as off duty, where that conduct has an effect on the education system...."

Reporter: "In speaking with the minster, he said one of the big challenges facing the new government is that many schools have fallen into disrepair. I asked if he had any figures on the total cost of the backlog, but he wasn't able to provide any. I notice a recent Tyee story cited a ministry figure of \$5 billion in deferred maintenance. Can you confirm whether that came from the ministry, how recently and whether it's accurate?"

Recommendation: Send background info from the Ministry:

The Ministry does not rely on "deferred maintenance estimates" to establish provincial needs or to distribute capital funding but is aware that the provincial estimate for deferred maintenance is approximately \$5 Billion.

Deferred maintenance does not indicate the actual condition of components or systems in schools nor the costs for replacements – as it does not recognize replacement parts within components in schools – or regular maintenance undertaken. Nor does it represent when components will actually need to be replaced. Only regular inspection and maintenance investment tracking can inform this.

For example, if a boiler has a 25 year manufacturer's suggested life, then at year 26 the full cost of replacement would be tracked as a potential "deferred

maintenance liability" – regardless of whether it actually needs to be replaced due to condition or performance.

Given school districts employ significant expertise in trades people, they regularly maintain and often replace wearable parts within components and are able to greatly prolong the life of building components beyond the manufacturer's suggested life.

Request: Reporter: "I'm doing a number of interviews for a commissioned article for the Watershed Sentinel that will be written by Briony Penn on the new BC curriculum, and I'm looking for an NDP response to the current curricula, given the background story of the controversial curriculum changes between 2014 and 2016, which I'm sure you're very familiar with.

Firstly, Briony is seeking a general response.

And secondly: does the New ministry of Education have there any plans to revisit the

curricula, given teachers' concerns about the second, behind-closed-doors edit in 2016 (that again removed topics of weather, interdependence of living and non-living things in ecosystems, and sustainability in the harvesting of natural resources, from grades three, four, and five)?"

Recommendation: Send the following information on Background from the Ministry of Education:

B.C.'s new curriculum ensures that in each grade students are expected to demonstrate the knowledge and understandings acquired in relation to the environment.

One of the challenges with the shift to a concept-based curriculum is that there can sometimes be a perception of missing or not covering topics.

Concepts within the new curriculum model can and do include multiple topics and provide the white space (flexibility) for a variety of topics to be explored in various levels of detail. The concept of weather, as an example, has not been removed and is explicitly covered in a variety of ways and in a variety of grades. The concept starts in Kindergarten at the simplest of levels and progresses each year to expand and add more complexity and dimensions.

Similar to the concepts at each grade, students start off at a more simple level, such as demonstrating their experiences and interpretations of the local environment, and progress with each grade where they are expected to begin demonstrating their understandings through observations, analyses, and predictions.

As in every curricular area, the final editing processes result in change. The changes may be grammatical, conceptual, or topical to ensure consistency within the area of learning and/or across all areas of learning or with the overall curriculum model. B.C.'s science curriculum review team included experts in environmental education, environmental education teachers, as well as representatives from environmental education organizations.

With the K-9 science curriculum, once the changes were completed, they were shared with the entire curriculum team and posted in July 2016.

Feedback received was for a clear conceptual flow of science concepts through the grades where concepts could be built upon in subsequent years. B.C.'s science curriculum will be discussed again in the next round of review and considerations (following the 2017/2018 school year).

Moving forward, Minister Fleming's mandate includes prioritizing the implementation of B.C.'s new curriculum and ensuring that teachers have the tools they need in the classroom to be successful.

According to the results, "students in the majority-language school system outperformed students in the minority-language school system by 62 points in Canada overall." (page 4 of report). While there was no statistical difference in majority/minority students in Manitoba and New Brunswick, majority language students in B.C., Nova Scotia and Ontario outperformed their minority language counterparts.

My questions are: Is the provincial government aware of the results and if so, is there an explanation?

As well, does it have a plan to improve financial literacy knowledge among students in the minority language set?

Recommendation: Send this response on background from the Ministry: Financial literacy is an important part of a comprehensive education for all students.

B.C.'s new curriculum explicitly includes financial literacy in all grades as part of mathematics. Historically, financial literacy was typically covered in the graduation years.

The Canadian Results of the OECD PISA 2015 Study have been shared with the Ministry of Education. This assessment took place prior to implementation of the new curriculum.

While there is room for improvement, the average scores for both majority and minority language students in B.C. were higher than the Canadian average and higher than all other participating provinces.

What is an IDIR?

Your IDIR is the unique identifier you use to log on to your workstation and to access many government applications, including Employee Self Service, where your leave and pay information is located, and AskMyHR, where you can get answers for a variety of questions related to your employment.

Your branch administrator or supervisor will let you know your IDIR ID and your temporary password on or near your first day of work. You will have to change this password when you log on to your workstation for the first time.

It is recommended that you restart your computer after logging on for the first time. After you've successfully rebooted and logged back on to your workstation, you will have to validate your IDIR.

Validating Your IDIR

You won't be able to validate your IDIR on your first day of work if you are new to the BC Public Service.

Follow these steps:

- Start at the <u>Time & Pay Portal</u>
- Click on the Self Service (PeopleSoft) tab and launch the application by clicking the

icon in the middle of the window

- Click on Click here to begin ESS Validation
- Enter your six digit employee number and use the drop-down calendar to enter your date of birth
- Click Submit. You should get a response that says, "You have successfully validated your IDIR"
- Wait 30 minutes
- Go back to Employee Self Service. When you launch the application this time you will be taken to the icons to view your pay, and other features
- If you don't see the icons, go to the <u>Time & Pay Portal</u>, click on the Self Service (PeopleSoft) tab and follow the instructions in the yellow box to clear your cache

You will now have access to most government websites, but there are a few such as the Learning Centre and the Hiring Centre that will take an overnight refresh before you will be able to access them.

You will need your employee number and date of birth to validate.

If you do not know your employee number, please let me know and I will give it to you. Also, if you have any problems, please let me know.
