**SUBJECT:** Information on Seismic Projects in Vancouver SD

#### **BULLETS:**

- The province is fully committed to providing funding for the seismic mitigation program in Vancouver until there are enough safe seats for every student.
- Access to capital funding is not an impediment to accelerating projects in Vancouver however before project funding can be approved, the school district, the Vancouver Project Office, the Ministry and other partners must all work together to manage swing space requirements and develop defensible business cases so the Ministry can access provincial capital funding from the Ministry of Finance.
- It is also important for all of us to demonstrate success, which is why government is
  focused on finding ways to accelerate the planning and delivery of seismic projects and
  we are looking to the Vancouver Project Office and school district to identify ways we
  can work together to ensure this is achieved.
- At this time, the VPO is finding it challenging to meet deadlines, and the length of the project schedules are long in comparison to other school districts. For example, David Lloyd George Elementary in Vancouver is a \$24.2 million seismic replacement and Handsworth Secondary in North Vancouver is also a \$62.3 million seismic replacement. Both were announced on the same day and will be completed at the same time, even though Handsworth Secondary has a significantly larger scope of work.
- According to the Vancouver Project Office Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), which was recently renewed on August 7, 2017, the Vancouver Board of Education has committed to update their long range facilities plan annually; however, this has not been done since May 2016.
- Government and the Vancouver Board of Education need to work collaboratively to
  ensure the seismic mitigation program in Vancouver is completed efficiently and cost
  effectively because ultimately safety is the top priority for the Ministry.

### Specific Project Information:

Ten seismic projects are currently underway in the Vancouver School District, worth over \$200 million:

- David Lloyd George Elementary \$24.2 million seismic replacement design
- Sir Mathew Begbie Elementary \$22.4 million seismic replacement design
- Bayview Elementary \$24.5 million seismic replacement design
- Kitsilano Secondary \$62.2 million seismic upgrade and replacement construction
- Sir Sandford Fleming Elementary \$19.6 million seismic replacement tender award/construction
- Lord Tennyson Elementary \$24.5 million replacement design
- Lord Nelson Elementary \$24.4 million seismic replacement construction
- Dr. Annie B. Jamieson Elementary \$13.1 million seismic upgrade construction
- Sir Charles Kingsford-Smith Elementary \$11.6 million seismic upgrade construction
- Maple Grove Elementary \$24.4 million seismic replacement design

Four seismic projects have been recently completed in Vancouver, worth over \$77 million:

- Lord Strathcona Elementary \$25.6 million seismic upgrade
- General Gordon Elementary \$16.5 million seismic replacement
- L'Ecole Bilingue Elementary \$15.2 million seismic replacement
- Queen Mary Elementary \$20.3 million seismic upgrade and partial replacement
- ➤ The 65 schools on the east side of Vancouver are currently operating at a 75% capacity utilization with 8,656 surplus seats.
  - o 17 schools have been complete or are underway with an average operating capacity of 91% and 758 surplus seats.
  - 11 schools are rated low to medium risk with an average operating capacity of 77% and 717 surplus seats.
  - 37 schools are rated high risk with an average operating capacity of 69% and
     7,181 surplus seats.

**SUBJECT:** Recruitment & Retention Task Force

#### **BULLETS:**

 The Minister's Task Force on Recruitment and Retention presented its findings in December.

- The Task Force concluded the vast majority of hiring related to the Memorandum of Agreement had been completed. However, the consequences of this hiring were:
  - Difficulties filling vacancies in certain specialty teaching positions were exacerbated;
  - Smaller, and in some cases, significant reductions in the number and availability of Teachers Teaching on Call (TTOC), and an impact on non-enrolling teachers reassigned to fill enrolling vacancies; and
  - Worsening pre-existing shortages of teachers in rural and remote districts across the province.
- The Task Force also identified as future challenges:
  - Remedies for exceeding MOA class size and composition requirements may put a further strain on non-enrolling teachers and TTOC lists; and
  - Potential increases in attrition and a rise in turnover rates of teachers.
- The Task Force acknowledged the autonomy of school districts to managing staffing in their districts.
- The Ministry is looking options to implement the recommendations, including supports to increase HR capacity at the district level.
- To address systemic and long term challenges, through the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training, BCPSEA received funding to establish a Labour Market Partnership. The steering committee for this partnership includes representation from the BCSTA as well as the BCSSA. A final report is expected by summer 2018.

#### Other:

- SD 39 (Vancouver) received \$35.2M in CEF (\$22.4M for staffing, \$9.3M for overhead, \$3.5M for remedies). The \$22.4M in staffing costs are for 250.5 FTE teaching positions.
- Between Oct. 15, 2016 and Oct. 15, 2017, SD 39 added 148.4 FTE teaching positions. The number of EA positions did not change. During this same period, SD 39 saw a 0.8% (375 students) decrease in student enrolment and the student to teacher ratio dropped from 17.3 to 16.3.

•	Also during this period, SD 39 saw 67 teacher move into the district from other districts and 80 teachers move to other district, for a net loss of 13 teachers to other districts.
