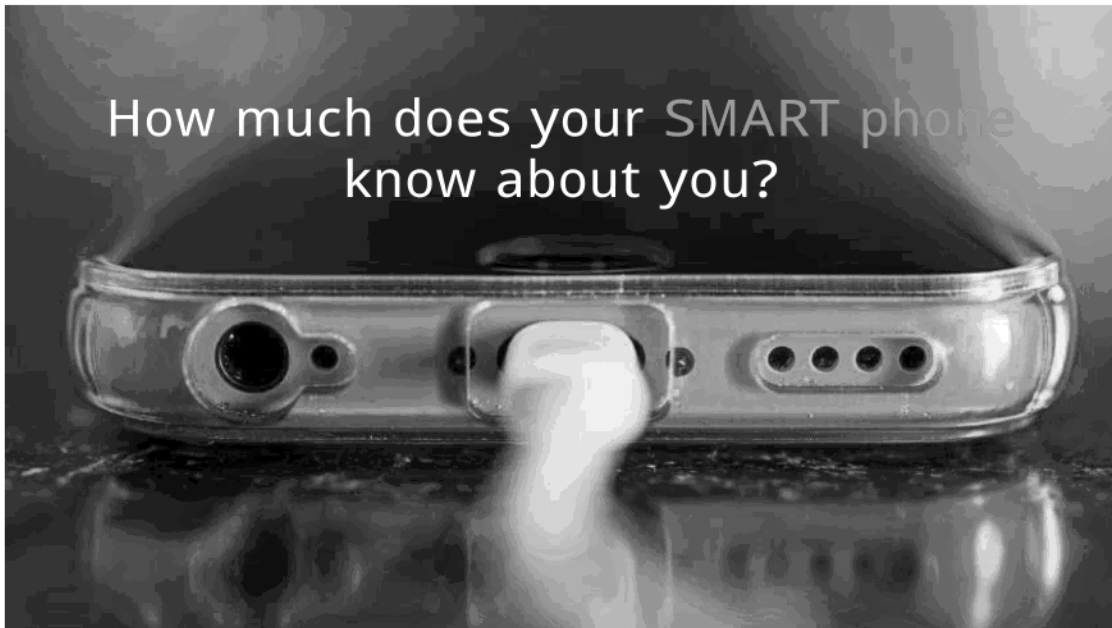

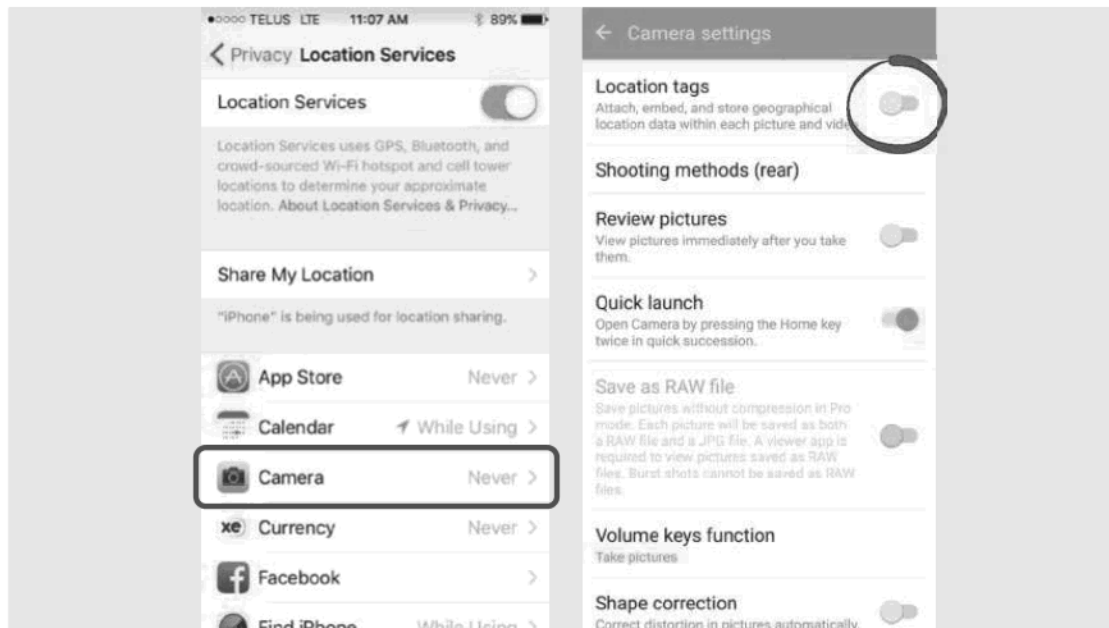

Self-Peer Exploitation (Sexting)

- “Youth creating, sending or sharing sexual images and/or videos with peers via the internet and/or electronic devices (cell phone messaging, messaging apps, social networking sites, etc.)”
- Be aware that adolescents do not typically share experiences they are embarrassed or ashamed of with their parents – don’t assume you would know if there was a problem
- Youth will make errors in judgment – it is all part of growing up
- The circulation of sexual images/videos among peers and their distribution via the internet can have short and long term impacts.

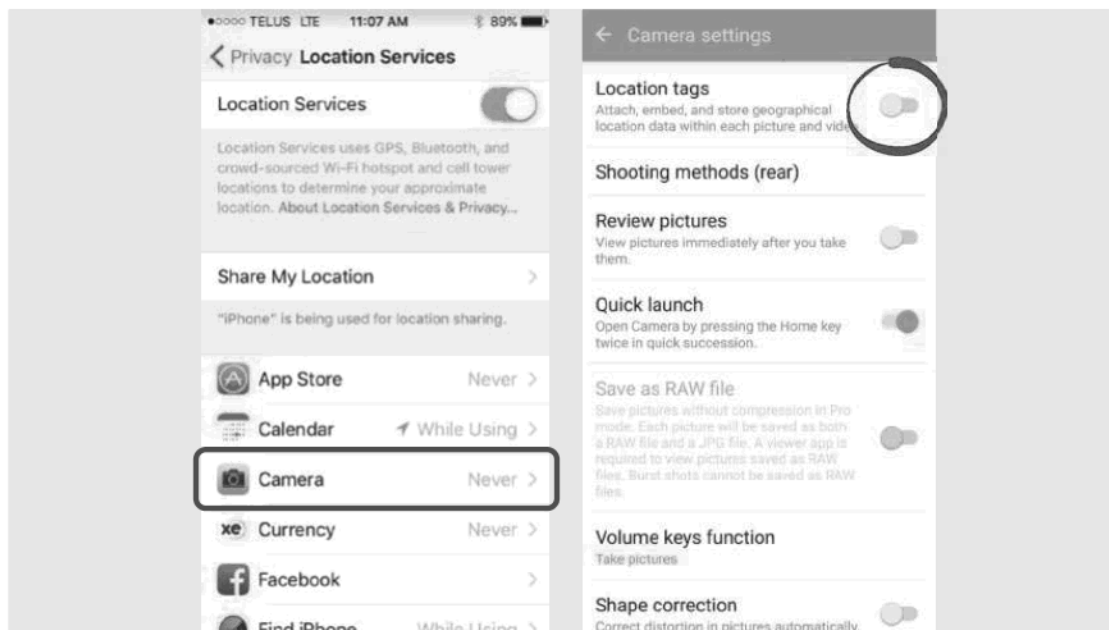

On another note, the Office of the Chief Information Officer is organizing another Security Day event on May 30, 2018. The theme of this year's event will be based on the idea of "information security back to basics" and they'll be inviting speakers to present on a variety of awareness topics that would be of use to anyone. One of the topics will most likely be related to children and youth online safety and they were wondering if we could recommend a subject matter expert to deliver a presentation on this topic. Would Sam be available to present?
