SUBJECT: MRF requesting bullets on progress being made on Richard McBride Elementary for meeting with Minister Darcy

BULLETS:

- All high risk seismic project business cases are reviewed by the ministry on their own merit, with respect to the proposed scope, schedule and budget.
- Each year the ministry builds its 10 year Capital Plan, which is informed by School District's 5 year plans, as part of government's annual budget process.
- McBride Elementary is included in the ministry's existing 10 year capital plan, however has not yet been brought forward for funding approval.
- The Ministry received the draft business case for Richard McBride Elementary in November 2016.
- The School District provided an updated budget for the original draft business case in June 2017.
- The School District provided an updated draft business case on January 10th 2018 with added scope to address the current over capacity (117%) at the school and the City of New Westminster's plans for housing development in the McBride area.
- The Ministry is currently reviewing the business case.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The seismic upgrade of the school is budgeted at \$15.2 million.
- The school also has significant building envelope issues and is on the Ministry's Building Envelope Program (BEP) priority list and is ranked at number 14.
- The BEP work identified in the business case is estimated at \$6.0 million.
- To mitigate both the seismic and building envelope issues at the school is estimated at \$22.56 million.
- Replacement of the school is estimated at \$20.94M and would not address the existing portables on site used for over capacity and childcare.
- The recommended option is is estimated at \$22.64M and includes 3 additional classrooms to address capacity issues and 3% NLC for two childcare classrooms.
- Budget and schedule are not yet finalized.
