This year's commemoration will take place on **Thursday, November 8th, beginning at 7 p.m. at Congregation Emanu-El Synagogue,** 1461 Blanshard Street, Victoria, BC V8W 2J3.

We are a diverse collective of Shoah survivors, descendants, educators and caring individuals whose primary focus is to continue finding innovative, informative and inspiring ways to honour, commemorate and educate about the Shoah. We are sponsored by Congregation Emanu-El.

On Thursday, November 8th, we will together remember what took place on the evening of November 9th, 1938. Kristallnacht targeted Jews solely for who they were with planned attacks on Jewish owned stores, buildings, and synagogues in Germany and Austria while authorities did nothing to stop the assault. The name "Kristallnacht" refers to the pieces of broken glass covering the streets but represents the broken lives, forever changed by this tragedy.

I hope this e-mail finds you well. The following information bullets were created for your constituents query, regarding vaccinations:

- The communication to parents/guardians and staff at Fleetwood Park Secondary School, including the directive for un-immunized staff and students to stay away from the school until November 26, 2018, unless proof of immunity is obtained, was issued by the Fraser Health Authority (FHA), not the Surrey School District: https://www.surreyschools.ca/schools/fltsec/NewsEvents/Newsletters/Documents/Fraser%20Health%20Letters.pdf
- In BC, a Medical Health Officer (MHO) has the legislated power through the *Health Act* to declare an outbreak. Typically, a disease outbreak is defined as the occurrence of disease in excess of what would normally be expected in a defined community, geographical area or season. As measles is extremely rare in Canada, an outbreak could be declared after one or more cases have been identified.
- Immunization is not mandatory in Canada; however, in the event of an outbreak, a MHO has the power to exclude individuals from attending a public place (such as a school) until the outbreak has been declared over. Only a MHO can declare an outbreak over.
- FHA cannot comment on the immunization status of individuals due to privacy and confidentiality related issues.
- FHA and the Ministry of Health have made a policy decision to not offer exposure testing to children at this time. However, parents wishing to determine previous exposure and immunity levels with measles are free to visit their family physician to make this request for testing. For children who are unimmunized, and who have had no previous infection of measles, it can be safely assumed that there has not been exposure and therefore exposure/immunity testing is not necessary.
- Children who are unimmunized can receive a vaccine free of charge. If immunization services are waived, unimmunized children must wait until the outbreak has been declared as over before returning to class
- Additional questions and concerns regarding the measles outbreak and FHA's directive can be directed to staff at the Guildford Health Unit at (604) 587-4750.
- Additional questions and concerns regarding unimmunized staff attending school can be directed to the school principal, or to the Surrey School District at (604) 596-7733.
