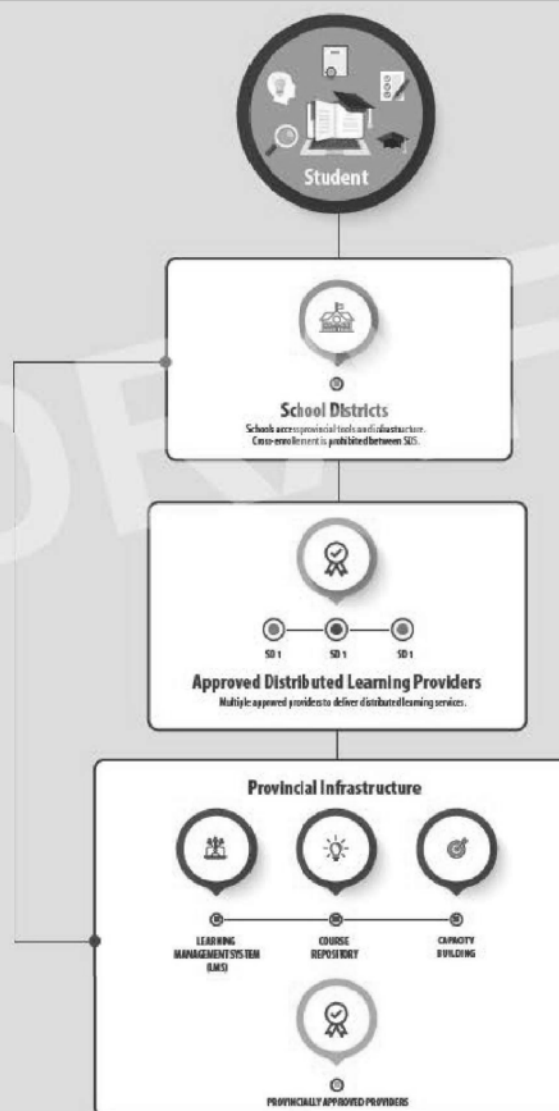

Our Task

To assist the Ministry of Education in determining the best approach to implementing *Recommendation 10* of the Independent Review Panel's report:

With the shift to a per-student-based funding model, the Ministry should develop a new policy and program delivery model for Distributed Learning to ensure consistent access to quality programming for all students in the province.



Working Group Summary

Over its meetings, the Working Group has:

- defined challenges and opportunities that exist within Distributed Learning;
- revised the vision statement for Distributed Learning,
- collected and reviewed relevant data on course completion to articulate/provide evidence on the current successes and challenges;
- developed student profiles aka “holograms” and the document “Student Journey” to better understand the range of learners in Distributed Learning programs, their learning needs, and their goals;
- provided advice on key policy questions related to Distributed Learning, from system, district, and school perspectives;



Our Work Included...

- defined positive and negative implications for different funding approaches (i.e. course-based funding, program-based funding, a combination/hybrid funding option);
- suggested mitigations for potential issues arising from different funding approaches;
- workshopped the 22 recommendations for a common understanding, to understand the connections with recommendation #10, and to discuss the strengths and weaknesses of the recommendations.



Summary of Discussion Themes

- Current funding model and how it works
 - Discussion of the current model included 1) the challenges associated with different funding for online vs. bricks and mortar learning, 2) the level of flexibility and choice inherent in both types of learning, 3) and the challenges of cross enrollment for funding.
- Jurisdictional scan
 - Overview of research and international scan of practice.
- Governance, quality assurance, capacity and looking to the future
 - Distributed Learning (DL) and bricks and mortar learning need to focus on the student.
 - The new model must address and create a solution for the competition for students and funding among various DL providers (e.g. public, independent).



Summary of Discussion Themes

- Accountability and fiscal responsibility
 - Accountability must not interfere with teaching.
 - Funding must be made equal between DL and bricks and mortar, as must auditing.
 - How to fund cross enrollment, students taking more than 8 courses, 3 times per year vs. once, etc.
 - How do we address loss of revenue due to students attending classes outside of their home districts?
- Equity and Access
 - DL must improve learning for special education, rural access (keeping in mind that not all SD's offer DL), and those students that cannot access a course at their school.
 - Equity is not necessarily a dollar value.
- Independent DL
 - Whatever changes take place in public DL, Independent DL should align.
