

The officer will act as the link between community groups and the City's Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).



The Officer will create strategies to maximize the collective community response to social challenges and ensure a strong social infrastructure in the community that will support initiatives to respond to COVID-19.

The Officer will seek to develop cooperation by developing creative and innovate solutions, driven by strong decision making.



In accordance with Ministerial Order 084, Item 8(1), and the letter from Emergency Management BC dated April 2, 2020 (from Stan Bates, Executive Director, Response) regarding local governments supporting community responses for vulnerable populations, the City of Penticton requested funding for a Social Services Officer (EMBC Resource Request Number: Res-143943-106-033120). This was approved by PREOC/EMBC/Province on April 6, 2020 at 13:32. The original approval was for funding up to the end of May 2020. On May 27, 2020, the City requested that this be extended to July 4, 2020. The Province approved this request on June 5, 2020 (Res-085534-547-052820). The City anticipates needing the Officer until at least Saturday, August 8, 2020, and are therefore requesting continued funding for the Officer up until this date.

Broadly, this role will support Penticton's municipality, EOC, provincial entities (e.g., BC Housing, Interior Health Authority), and community partners by:

- Acting as a liaison between community groups and agencies in responding to community health and social challenges with vulnerable individuals related to COVID-19 (e.g., homeless, low income, isolated elderly).
- Acting as the link between partners and the City's Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).
- Creating strategies to continue to maximize the collective community response to social challenges and ensuring a strong social infrastructure in the community that support initiatives to respond to COVID-19.
- Working collaboratively with the EOC Information Officer on media relations for social issues.
- Collaborate with other City departments, such as Bylaw Services, to ensure a coordinated response.
- Developing cooperation by developing creative and innovate solutions, driven by strong decision making.



More specifically, from July 5 – August 8, we anticipate that the Officer will:

- Participate in regular meetings with BC Housing, Interior Health, the City, and community partners (e.g., agencies, RCMP). These meetings (happen a minimum of once every week) are a direct request from BC Housing.
- BC Housing has identified a location for an additional COVID-related emergency shelter and hygiene station. The City has received numerous calls from neighbouring land owners and tenants about BC Housing's location and operations that require significant Officer time to reply to. Additionally, the Officer will help coordinate with City departments (e.g., calls for service, inspections, approval of permits) related to this and related locations.
- Interior Health Authority is providing in-reach supports at the provincially coordinated agriculture worker camps that surround Penticton. As a hub community, not-for-profit services are receiving increased demand for services from individuals in these provincial camps. The Officer will help coordinate the community's response for increased service calls to these provincial camps.
- Supporting the community in applying for grants to support COVID-19-related initiatives (e.g., federal community emergency funds through the United Way, recently announced Work BC youth program).
- Collaborate with Bylaws and RCMP to maximize the efficient of resources when the public/agencies call for support.
- Coordinate public communication of community issues and opportunities for all members of the public to become involved.

- Strategize to develop a stronger food supply system for the food bank, the food bank's clients, and the food bank's community partners (e.g., other agencies) that receive food.
- Liaise with senior serving agencies to support the growing local concern of isolated seniors, and the lack of capacity in agencies to respond in a timely fashion to all requests for support from isolated seniors (e.g., groceries, socialization, transportation, meals, utilities).
