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Andrew,

Thanks for making the time yesterday.

To follow-up on a few things mentioned, I'm sending along a note with some supplemental materials and some additional context around the items we discussed.

1. Hydrogen –

- that hydrogen slide we showed is from a longer deck we spun Les M and other EMLI staff through last month. Have attached the full deck here.
- If you'd like to have a longer conversation on this, we'd be happy to find a time to walk you through this material.

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2. Resiliency –

- You may recall that Dave and I briefed you and Melissa on our resiliency initiatives a long, long way back, not long after the Enbridge Rupture.
- Two of those initiatives (Tilbury Storage and the Advanced Metering Initiative) are now being advanced through the respective regulatory processes.
- We filed the draft Detailed Project Description for the Tilbury 2 project last month, which is what will trigger the public comment period we mentioned later this year.
- I anticipate we'll file the CPCN for the Advanced Metering Initiative in the coming weeks. You'll recall that we've been doing workshops with MLAs, CAOs etc since the start of the new year in anticipation of this filing.

For the Jetty and Tilbury 2 EA public comment periods, I'll continue to flag these for you and your team. But again, don't hesitate to reach out directly if you have any questions on these projects.
