## Purpose of Reserve:

The attached Regulation will establish a mineral and placer NRR and a CLR over areas concerning four separate reserve requests. Information on each request follows.

- Mount Robson Park Addition MoE has requested this reserve in order to ensure no claims are acquired over the area that is to be added to the Mount Robson Park. This addition is being undertaken to provide an exchange area for a parcel that will be removed from the park to facilitate the expansion of a gas pipeline through the park. There are no mineral, placer or coal tenure conflicts with the proposed park addition.
- Atlin Recreation Area Coverage by a NRR was removed from the Atlin Recreation Area in 1997 because it was deemed that recreation area status under the Park Act would serve as sufficient protection for the area. However, Government has request that parks not use the recreation area means of protection any longer and has subsequently requested a NRR until alternate designation can take place. There are no mineral, placer or coal tenure conflicts with the Atlin Recreation Area established under the Mineral Tenure Act.

- Camp Barnard & Camp Thunderbird As an administrative step, it has been decided to place a mineral, placer and coal NRR over the sites of both camps to ensure no tenure acquisition occurs over the areas. The reserve will also ensure that no free miners cross over or enter the sites for any exploration and development work. There are no mineral, placer or coal tenure conflicts with the areas covered by the Camp Barnard and Camp Thunderbird sites. There are numerous mineral tenure conflicts with these sites, however, should MEMPR wish these tenures extinguished, they would be solely responsible for negotiating a Quit Claim Agreement with the tenure holders.
- Haida Gwaii Sites 1-7 These areas are being reserved in accordance with the proposed Haida Gwaii Strategic Land Use Agreement. Section 4.2 of the Agreement stipulates that reserves under the Forest Act, Mineral Tenure Act and Petroleum and Natural Gas Act will be established over the proposed Protected Areas upon initialling of the document. This Agreement will not be signed until Cabinet approval has been given to the additions; however, it is unknown when this will occur. To minimize potential compensation issues, reserves under the Mineral Tenure Act and Petroleum and Natural Gas Act are being established at this time. Your signature on the attached Regulation will establish the required protection. There are numerous mineral tenure conflicts with these areas; however, should ILMB wish these titles extinguished, it would be their sole responsibility to negotiate a Quit Claim Agreement with the tenure holders.

#### Duration:

The attached Regulation currently has no expiration date; however, each reserve has a review date associated with it that will occur between December 31, 2009 and December 31, 2011. At these times, the Mineral Titles Branch will contact the respective requestor to determine whether continued coverage by a reserve is warranted over the corresponding sites.

Referrals (Ministry of Agriculture and Lands (MAL) Policy/Regional staff, other Ministries, agencies, relevant committees):

All of these requests have been reviewed and supported by various staff of the aforementioned Ministries. Some of these requests are of an administrative nature, therefore, require no further referrals.

Based on the above, the Titles and Offshore Division recommends that the Mount Robson Park Addition, Atlin Recreation Area, Camp Barnard & Camp Thunderbird, and the Haida Gwaii – Sites 1-7 have reserves established over them.






