ISSUE: Ksi Lisims LNG

BACKGROUND:

Rockies LNG Partners is a group of western Canada natural gas producers collaborating to develop an LNG export project on the north coast of British Columbia (BC). They have been exploring potential sites around the Prince Rupert area and working collaboratively with the Nisga'a Nation and Western LNG, a Texas-based LNG developer.

Ksi Lisims LNG is a partnership between the Nisga'a, Rockies LNG Partners and Western LNG. The project envisions a floating liquefaction facility capable of exporting upwards of 12 million tonnes per annum of LNG near the village of Gingolx in the Prince Rupert area. The project aims to be a net-zero LNG facility and could employ as many as 4,000 people during construction. If sanctioned, production could start by late 2026 or 2027. The project has been negotiating for pipeline access with both TC Energy on the Prince Rupert Gas Transmission Project (PRGT) and Enbridge on the Westcoast Connector Gas Transmission Project (WCGT). Both pipeline projects face seeing their Environmental Assessment Certificates (EAC) expire if the projects are not substantially started by November 25, 2024. Ksi Lisims LNG faces a challenging and tight timeline to develop their project to secure the means to transport natural gas feedstock from one of these pipeline projects.

TC Energy owns PRGT, a proposed 900-kilometre natural gas pipeline that would run from Hudson's Hope to Lelu Island, near Prince Rupert. The pipeline route would include both terrestrial and marine sections and would have an initial capacity of 2 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d) (expandable to 3.6 Bcf/d). PRGT has an Environmental Assessment Certificate (EAC) from the BC Environmental Assessment Office (EAO) and all primary pipeline permits from the BC Oil and Gas Commission (OGC). PRGT must be substantially started by November 25, 2024, or the EAC will expire.

Enbridge owns the WCGT, a proposed 850-kilometre natural gas pipeline from the Cypress area in northeast BC to Ridley Island, near Prince Rupert. The pipeline route would include both terrestrial and marine sections and would have an initial capacity of 2.2 Bcf/d (expandable up to approximately 8.4 Bcf/d). WCGT's EAC is set to expire on November 25, 2024.

DISCUSSION:

On March 12 of this year, Nisga'a Nation president Eva Clayton said it is undertaking a "collaborative endeavours" process with Western LNG and Rockies LNG on the Ksi Lisims

LNG project. Clayton has noted that attracting an economic base to the Nass Valley has been a major priority for the Nisga'a Nation. Ksi Lisims LNG has spent the last several months collaborating, preparing documents for regulatory processes and just recently started community outreach. To date, Ksi Lisims LNG has not formally met with Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation (EMLI) staff to discuss the project.

Discussions between the Nisga'a and Rockies LNG Partners are ongoing. The project has yet to apply for an export license from the Canada Energy Regulator and has just recently submitted initial paperwork to provincial and federal environmental assessment agencies. The project has been negotiating with both TC Energy and Enbridge on pipeline access to transport feedstock to the proposed facility.

Ksi Lisims LNG External Relations Manager, Paul Anderson, spoke to the Terrace City Council on June 29 regarding the project, outlining the timelines and environmental approvals required to see the project reach a positive Final Investment Decision (FID) by late 2023. The Ksi Lisims LNG project faces a tight timeline for its environmental approvals and development timelines, as both possible feedstock pipelines, Enbridge's WCGT and TC Energy's PRGT, face having their EACs expire if they do not meet the substantially started requirement in November 2024. This implies that financial commitments required to proceed with Ksi Lisims must be in place by the end of 2023.

On July 5 Ksi Lisims LNG filed initial paperwork seeking environmental assessment with both the provincial and federal environmental assessment agencies. In the Initial Project Description submitted to the EAO, Ksi Lisims LNG states the proponents are designing the project to be one of the lowest carbon emitting LNG export facilities in the world and targets to be Net Zero within 3 years of operating. This will be achieved by connecting to the BC Hydro power grid for its power source in combination with a monitoring and measurement program, design elements to reduce emissions, purchase of carbon offsets and the potential for carbon capture and sequestration.

After several multi-billion dollar LNG export projects have cancelled their development plans in western Canada, proponents are looking at different options for structuring their potential projects. Ksi Lisims LNG, like Cedar LNG, aim to de-risk their projects by having meaningful partnerships with First Nations. However, a significant barrier to meaningful project involvement is lack of equitable access to capital.

CONCLUSION:

The proposed Ksi Lisims LNG project could play an important role in Canada's natural gas industry and further allow domestic producers of natural gas access to new markets. Like Cedar LNG, the structure of ownership of the Ksi Lisims LNG project marks a new direction for major industrial development in the province. Furthermore, this project could become the anchor tenant that would allow either the PRGT or WCGT projects to move forward and unlock further developments in the northwest.
