The Mine manager shall complete the right hand column noting specific corrective actions taken by a specified date, and return a copy to the Inspector within 15 days of receiving the report. Further the manager shall post a copy to the bulletin board, to be replaced by a copy showing the manager's response. In this document, Code means Health, Safety and Reclamation Code for Mines in British Columbia.

INSPECTION ORDERS

A mine inspection was conducted on Wednesday May 28, 2014 accompanied by Gerry Barcelonia, Inspector of Mines. The following deficiencies were noted.

SECTION: 6.20.3 Dumping Over Bank

An oversize dump was found located along one of the access roads close to the truck loading area, the dump ramp did not have shoulder barriers and was accessible to traffic.

No person shall drive or operate a haulage vehicle, in such a manner as to dump material from the vehicle over a bank that is more than 3 m high, or dump within 3 m of the dump berm crest when the bank is more than 3 m high, except as described in section 6.10.1(4), unless a dump person is directing vehicles to the dumping position and a dump berm is in place.

MANAGERS RESPONSE OF ACTION TAKEN

As agreed with the loader operator acess to the dump was to be prevented by the immediate placement of local material at the entrace to the dump. The height of this berm will be at least ¾ the height of the largest tire on any vehicle hauling on the road.

SECTION :3.6.1 First Aid Supplies

The driver contacted on site was properly certified with Level 1 First Aid. The required Level 1 First Aid kit was not present for workers.

The manager shall provide and maintain first aid supplies and services as required by the Workers Compensation Board.

This deficiency was to be remedied by the shift following the date of inspection by the provision of a Level 1 First Aid Kit.

SECTION: 6.19.2 Logbook to be Maintained

The logbook for the loader on site was not found by the operator and had not been updated as required by the code.

The manager shall provide and maintain an effective logbook system for each unit of mobile equipment over 7000 kg gross vehicle weight where

- (a) the vehicle operator notes the operating condition prior to operating of the vehicle
- (b) note any unsafe conditions, and
- (c) a qualified person making repairs, notes any repairs made and if the vehicle is safe to operate.

This deficiency was to be remedied by the shift following ther date of inspection.

SECTION: 6.8.3 Traffic Control

Traffic control procedures were not posted at the site. Roads entering and exiting the pit area are too narrow for two way traffic.

Gravel trucks entering the site were in radio communication.

The manager shall prepare traffic control procedures, showing the maximum allowable speeds for the vehicles in use, rules for passing, "stop" and "yield rules," priority rules for various vehicles, rules for night operation, maximum operating grades, emergency runoff protection, shoulder barriers, and any other information that may be required to ensure the safe operation of all types of vehicles on the mine site.

Section: 6.9.1 Haulage Road Width
The manager shall prepare a plan pursuant to section
10 (1) of the *Mines Act* which

- (1) Shows the type and method of construction for haulage roads that are to be constructed at the mine site.
- (2) Except for roads constructed prior to 1990, the manager shall ensure that haulage roads are designed, constructed and maintained to provide
- (a) a travel width where dual lane traffic exists, of not less than 3 times, or where single lane traffic exists, of not less than 2 times the width of the widest haulage vehicle used on the road, and
- (b) a shoulder barrier
- (i) at least 3/4 of the height of the largest tire on any vehicle hauling on the road,

As an alternative to widening the pit acess road to 3 times the width of haulage vehicles a two was traffic control system shall be initiated on the existing 2 way roads present close to the pit entance.

As discussed with the operator on site this requirement is to be carried out within 15 days of the inspection.

Manager's Response of Action Taken

- The conveyors at the crushing plant were found without suitable guards at nip points. Guards shall extend for a distance of at least 1m from the nip point. This deficiency shall be corrected immediately. Section 4.4.17(5) of the Mines Code and General Rules. Re: crusher and screen product conveyors.
- An Occupational Health & Safety Committee shall be formed and inspect the operations monthly. A meeting of this Committee shall follow the inspection. Section 1.6.1 of the Mines Code and General Rules.
- Minutes of the Occupational Health & Safety Committee meetings shall be forwarded monthly to the District Inspector in Nanaimo. Section 1.6.3(3) of the Mines Code and General Rules. Sample left.
- Records of training for workers, pursuant to Sec. 1.11.1 to 1.11.5 of the Mines Code and General Rules shall be kept by the manager to be reviewed by the Inspector of Mines as required. Sample left.
