#### Response:

We suggest that you contact FortisBC regarding implications of yesterday's announcement for their rates.

**FYI for the MO:** GCPE-SDPR provided the following to this reporter Oct. 30, 2017 – GCPE-EMPR provided the first three bullets in the response regarding two-tiered rates.

Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen CAO Bill Newell spoke to Minister Simpson at UBCM re: the impact those on rural properties are facing with the 2 tier billing.

Q: Is this something the new ministry will be looking at?

- The B.C. Utilities Commission (BCUC) reviewed Fortis BC's and BC Hydro's two-tiered rates system in response
  to concerns from customers that their electricity bills are too high.
- Almost 700 customers and groups, many of them members of the public, participated in the review.
- After listening and reviewing everyone's concerns, the BCUC determined the two-tiered rate system is fair and balanced, and that the vast majority of low-income customers benefit from two-tiered rates compared to a flat rate.
- That said, our government is developing a Poverty Reduction Strategy starting with a public consultation process that will begin before the end of the year.
- We appreciate there are still concerns about two-tiered rates for those on fixed incomes especially as we approach winter when heating costs increase.
- We understand that utilities are significant expense for those on modest incomes. We will be asking the Poverty Reduction Advisory Forum to give us advice related to the costs of essential services such as utilities as part of our overall poverty reduction strategy
- We welcome individuals who are impacted by the two-tiered billing to continue to share their experiences through the poverty reduction public consultations and online engagement.


