



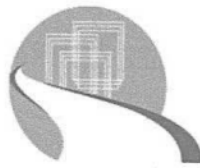

Vast Sourcing Solutions Inc. submitted a mine plan dated September 24, 2019.

In discussions with staff it was agreed we could accept a phase of the September 24, 2020 mine plan in order to address the tall wall and bring it into compliance. We could accept the southern cross section which covered the very high vertical wall.

I discussed the tall wall with the Agriculture Land Commission and received verbal approval from them that work could commence to bring the tall wall down for safety reasons.

On May 27, 2020, I gave verbal approval for the tall wall to be brought into compliance with the Code as per the southern phase of the mine plan.
