Sean – based on our conversation I just followed up with MLA Trevena. I told her that:

- FLNR F&W Branch has a role to play in decisions around the suitability of rehabilitation for orphaned animals (like these bear cubs)
- There is a checklist/protocol that is used that includes consideration of factors like food conditioning, habituation to people or human food, and the overall health of the animal
- The decision is made by FLNR F&W Branch, including senior wildlife biologists the provincial wildlife veterinarian, and the COS.
- The two bear cubs from Port Hardy have been shipped to Errington to the rehabilitation centre.

It was a short call – she thanked me for the information about the process.
