They questioned if the 'closure' area was just the space between the islands to which I informed them the RCA surrounded the islands to a depth of 40m. At this point they sped away exceeding the 7 knot limit near the marine mammal haul outs and caused a disturbance in which two or three California sea lions took to the water.



While patrolling Kal lake Prov park due to unlawful hunting complaints, CO Smith saw a Suzuki Tracker go up a barricaded side rd @ 3.5 km on the Cosens Bay rd. The truck had gone around the yellow steel post blocking the road. CO Smith managed to get his patrol truck around the post and pulled over the truck. The driver exited the vehicle with the shells to his rifle in his hand and the rifle floor plate open. It appeared to CO Smith that the driver had emptied his rifle prior to CO Smith getting to the rifle. The driver had no permit to drive off the designated Prov Park rd. During the conversation as to why he had driven off the road, the driver said he had driven to Kal Lake on the trail to week before. CO Smith told the driver that a complaint had been lodged regarding his driving to the lake as well. See statements below re this off road activity. The driver said that the barrier posts were no problem as he could go around them. The driver had 2 Border Collie dogs with him. CO Smith said it was unlawful to go around them, that is why they are there. The Tracker was @ 3.5 km marker, which CO Smith believes is within the Park, not the Protected Area.

I believe the trail which this individual access with his vehicle is the High Rim Trail, and as Brent said it's blocked with a no-post.

My opinion is that the no-post would make a reasonable person believe that a vehicle is not permitted to access that area. The section of the Park Act that would cover this is 24(1) Illegal Use of a Vehicle.

As Brent and I discussed yesterday, I will call the individual today. It seems like the individual has used his vehicle in this manner on more than one occasion. As for illegal hunting, I do not believe there is enough evidence of this individual hunting in a closed area to charge.

Kal Park is a confusing place to hunt after the PA was amalgamated with the Park. It is hard to tell where you are sometimes. I've worked with F/W for over two years to get a better map and information in the synopsis, but to no avail. I am not sure how signage would help as it would get confusing signing whether one was in the Park, former PA or private land. I'll work on it over the winter.



We then both walked over the hill and observed a leaning across S22 the hood of an older dark colored Ford Super Cab diesel [ with headache rack] and readying herself for another shot [which ensued] We approached the vehicle and took note of the licence numbe After the shot I approached and asked asked what they were up to . The lady shooter did not respond, so I asked the male driver [dressed in camo and using binoculars to spot for the shooter] what they were shooting at. He said there was a buck over there. We did see deer running during the shooting. There was at least one more shot taken while we were present. S22 then asked the lady if she was aware that this was Kal Park. She said she was and it was open. We walked away and the shooting continued [ counting nine shots in total] It should also be noted that they earlier had been observed parked at the bottom of the timbered switchbacks to Cosens Bay [a small parking spot there], before starting up and leaving as we walked nearer. Anyway, as we left the scene of the shooting and were continuing up the steep trail past the parking lot [now heading toward the red gate] we saw the truck in question leaving the park. On the way home we were fortunate enough to run into a police officer and reported the incident in it's entirety. He had already had a report of a Kal Park shooting. Today, when we were walking in Kal Park again hunting is still going on [we heard a shot], and in fact talked to a hunter

[dressed in camo with three border collies] in a white Suzuki Tracker. He denied taking a shot [ not sure about that], but thinks the whole area is open and is coming back. He even drove [ narrow wheel base] right down to Cosens Bay. Very disturbing, as there are many who walk the park daily. Thanks for your prompt attention to this matter,

s22 and myself were hiking the park. We were on the trail just west-east above the Cosens Bay Road. (approximately 200 yds. from the Cosens Bay parking lot).

We heard a number of rifle shots directly south of our position. We both walked over the hill and observed

S22 leaning across the hood of an older dark colored Ford Super Cab (diesel)(license number S22 In total we heard nine shoots, but actually only observed her taking several shoots.

When we came up to the truck and questioned the lady what she was doing, she would not respond. The spotter (male)(using binoculars) was in the truck, stated they were shooting at a buck (as he pointed towards the buck). We observed the deer running away.

We let the two know that they were in a park and perhaps they should not be hunting. The lady responded she knew it was a park, but it was open for hunting.

The shooting was reported to an RCMP constable shortly afterwards. We did not contact you sooner, as we were in the understanding that the RCMP would follow up with the reporting.

November 25, 2010 we came across another hunter (Suzuki Tracker/ white – license number unknown, with three border collies). We heard a rifle shot, but we did not witness the actual shot taken. We question the driver of his hunting; He denied taking a shot, but he did say he thought the whole park

was open for hunting. Because of the narrow wheel base vehicle, he even drove right down to Cosens Bay.

Kal park is used by many hikers, school groups, dog walkers and nature lovers. The fact that hunting it happening, and natural grounds are being disturbed troubles me. I trust/hope you will address the above.

I believe the trail which this individual access with his vehicle is the High Rim Trail, and as Brent said it's blocked with a no-post.

My opinion is that the no-post would make a reasonable person believe that a vehicle is not permitted to access that area. The section of the Park Act that would cover this is 24(1) Illegal Use of a Vehicle.

As Brent and I discussed yesterday, I will call the individual today. It seems like the individual has used his vehicle in this manner on more than one occasion. As for illegal hunting, I do not believe there is enough evidence of this individual hunting in a closed area to charge.

Kal Park is a confusing place to hunt after the PA was amalgamated with the Park. It is hard to tell where you are sometimes. I've worked with F/W for over two years to get a better map and information in the synopsis, but to no avail. I am not sure how signage would help as it would get confusing signing whether one was in the Park, former PA or private land. I'll work on it over the winter.

I just arrived back from a helicopter flight with Black Mtn. Irrigation District (BMID) to access possible environmental damage, and for the most part it appears they behaved this time. In the past I have received complaints regarding their activity in and around the Graystokes Protected area. At the time I used a snow machine and went into where their camp had been. I found a large crater melted into the snow. It was 5 ft. Deep and 40 ft. Across. They had cut down and burnt green trees, left all sorts of litter, and had driven their trucks threw the protected area. During this investigation I managed to find a truck permit left at their camp, and with this I managed to tracked down some of those responsible. Three tickets were issued; one for litter, one for the cutting of green trees and one going into the protected area with a vehicle. This 4X4 club has been carrying out this activity in this area for the last 30 years. Every year it occurs about this same time.

We believe that the flight which BLK. Mtn. Irrigation District did last Friday (May 6, 2011) over their camp let them know they were being watched, and prevented damage to the water shed. Blaine Gaffney from Global news, Kelowna, called and wanted an update. I let him know that the Fridays helicopter flight by (BMID) likely prevented serious environmental damage. Anyway just thought I better send this out so everyone is in the loop.

I first became aware of this last Friday, May 6/11, at 1600 hrs. I received a call from who hecking into it. Unfortunately I was the only CO working in had S22 Kelowna at the time, I told him that if given clearance I S22 would respond The next day I was given the go ahead from Sgt. Lockwood to check into this. CO Jones and I used our tundra snow machines to try and make it to their camp. On the way we intercepted one of their trucks coming out. He was on the road and there were no violations encountered. The 2 people in the truck advised us that their camp was still a long ways in and that would likely not make it with the small tundra snow machines. The snow was soft and heavy with the warm temperatures, and was getting deeper as we climbed in elevation. We decided that it would be in our best interest to turn around at this point as we probably would not make it to their camp.

Earlier before heading up I had spoken with S22 Operations Superintendent with BMID. He wanted a call regarding what we had found. When I arrived back at the office I called S22 nd he asked if I could go up with them in the Helicopter next day (Sunday) to access and deal with any violations. I told him that I would providing that I could get clearance from our agency. Weather was not permitting on Sunday, so we went up on the following day Monday to access.

During this fly we followed the tracks into their camp and checked to make sure no tracks went into the Graystokes protected area (Park). They drove along the park boundary, but for the most of it, stayed out. They cleaned up all garbage around their camp, so really not much in the way of violations, like in the past. It was believed that the helicopter flight on the Friday acted as a strong deterrent.

Yesterday we had

The first one is log listings by site and an accompanying each is a volume grade summary. The second is a compiled log listing and a value comparison. Ignore the fact that it is a comparison, I compared it to itself just to generate a value breakdown and total. Please remember that much of the volume is estimated (under water, in the air) and I would guess that a ten percent difference would not be unlikely. The grade breakdown should be sound though. The values are based on average market values about 60 days ago, they will probably be slightly less now. If you ever get them rounded up and accessible we could establish a proper scale.

As for disposing of them try Interfor, Coulson Forest Products or Probyn Log, or even just advertise them locally, I'm sure you will find a taker. I will ask tenures what we would have to do about getting a timber mark and let you know. Also they will eventually have to be properly scaled. Many of the purchasers could arrange the scaling for you.


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

















