Our backgrounds and perspectives are as diverse as the rest of the province. With this in mind, I am writing to gauge your interest in creating the first ever multi-partisan Indigenous caucus.

I recognize and honour the responsibilities and workload that we all carry to ensure our government continues to function. In this respect, I suggest the initial activity of this caucus to be no more than simply having lunch with each other prior to the close of the current session.

Please let me know if this is of interest and I will be in contact regarding next steps. In addition, should you be aware of any other members of your caucus who are of First Nations, Metis or Inuit heritage please let me know and extend this invitation to them.

I have been amazed at the game-playing that is indulged by all levels of the regulatory process with regard to the blatant impunity that is given to the investment industry to sell segregated funds under false pretenses.

As I said earlier today to you Ryan, I have been seeking^{s.22}

The regulators and the Office of the Ombudsperson need to be reminded that the analogy of what^{s.22}
s.22 is enduring - is akin to someone being told to negotiate with the holder of stolen property. It is not the
holder of stolen property as a secondary party to a theft - who is responsible for the crime. It is the person who
acted to perpetrate the crime, i.e., the investment company and its agents who knowingly put together a
deceptive scheme to hijack the funds of persons seeking to invest in Guaranteed Investment Certificates. The
Insurance Council of BC has stated that they are not the agency with jurisdiction -s.22
s.22, they are not supposed to look at evidence - a signed contract - that "may have
originated outside of BC". Surely we in this province need to have the presence of mind that the printing of a
document that may have been printed outside of BC, has no relevance to the process of offer and acceptance
and transfer of consideration that occurred entirely in^{s.22}

There is, in my view, no reason to indulge any form of deception in the sale of securities anywhere in BC - and
CERTAINLY not where the savings of someone^{s.22} is concerned.

It is disgraceful that our Ombudsperson service has been trained to say "we don't look at the criminal code". I
hope that the new social democratic government will quickly change this ridiculous policy. It is essential that
everyone at every level of the complaint process be FULLY educated to know the components of contract law
in detail - and that they demonstrate absolute fidelity to upholding the Criminal Code of Canada Rules against
any form of deception in sale of securities. Specifically Sections 361-363 and 380. It is an absolute betrayal of

accountability that these laws are now TOTALLY disregarded due to DE-REGULATION and PRIVATIZATION of governance of the investment industry.

I would appreciate a reply as to whether you feel that there should be any tolerance for a system that puts someone through s.22 betrayal by an investment dealer - and that the system knowingly and wilfully allows the capital value of the savings of an s.22 to be stolen using this m.o.
