Subject: The need for gender equality to protect BC children

Dear Ms. Dean, Secretary for Gender Equity,

The issue of gender bias is still an acute problem for children in BC family courts. Kids are regularly forced away from abundant access to a good parent by family court orders that don't work. We have asked the Attorney General to provide an "equal parenting presumption law" to the BC Family Law Act. The Ministry of Justice is dragging its feet for no good reason. Right now, only 10% of judicial outcomes are for shared parenting when an avalanche of research states that is harmful and that (equal) shared parenting is clearly in the best interest of the child. This is an ongoing disaster for kids that can easily be changed.

Currently BC FLA, Section 40, para. 4 states:

"In the making of parenting arrangements, no particular arrangement is presumed to be in the best interests of the child and without limiting that, the following must not be presumed:

(a)that parental responsibilities should be allocated equally among

guardians;

(b)that parenting time should be shared equally among guardians;

(c)that decisions among guardians should be made separately or together."

It must be changed to read:

"In making of parenting arrangements, equal parenting time and responsibility is presumed to be in the best interests of the child and without limiting that, a presumption of equal parenting time will be the starting place upon separation. The court may deviate from that if there is evidence of violence, neglect, incapacity, inability or disinterest by a parent towards the child."

The problem with the current reading of the FLA S.4, p.4 is:

a) It's contrary to all the social science research on the matter,

- b) that it leaves opportunity for the historic gender bias that hurts children,
- c) it leaves custody/parenting open to emotional, protracted litigation

that devastates families while lining the pockets of lawyers.

The only opposition to an "equal parenting presumption law" is the Canadian Bar Association and other lawyers who have only advanced empty reasoning. They are in a conflict of interest because a family lawyer's primary concern is to their client (the litigious parent), then, presumably their lively hood comes before the child's best interest.

A simple piece of legislation can help thousands of BC children right now. We are happy to meet with you at a mutually convenient time to discuss and create strategy for moving forward.
