We are certain that the success you achieved in previous roles, including the delivery of multiple surplus budgets while concurrently increasing spending on public services, will continue in your new role. We look forward to working together with you as you assume leadership of British Columbia's public services.

At TELUS, we see ourselves as a key partner of the government in creating resilient and healthy communities across the province. With more than 8,000 current employees and 12,000 retirees spread across every corner of the province, TELUS is the largest private-sector and unionized labour employer in B.C. We believe that it's important to "Give Where We Live," and as such, our team members and retirees have contributed more than \$185 million and 5.9 million volunteer hours in support of charitable and community organizations throughout B.C. since 2000.

Throughout 2020, as COVID-19 created serious challenges across the province, TELUS and the Government of B.C. were incredibly successful in partnering to support British Columbians through this crisis. While not exhaustive, some of TELUS' commitments in response to COVID include:


- Committing \$10 million through our TELUS Community Boards to 32 organisations across B.C. on the front line of the public health crisis, including \$400,000 in direct emergency crisis funding;
- Donating more than 10,000 mobile devices and tablets, valued at \$5 million, through our Mobility for Good Emergency response programme enabling hospitalised patients, isolated seniors and other vulnerable Canadians to stay in touch with health practitioners and their loved ones;

- Extending our Internet for Good programme to all B.C. students from kindergarten to grade 12, providing access to high-speed internet at home for only \$9.95 per month and ensuring students are connected to vital learning opportunities while home from school;
- Offering our Home Health Monitoring solution with a COVID-19 protocol, developed through the TSMA's Strategic Investment Fund, which has supported more than 1,000 British Columbians with chronic health conditions, or at risk/recovering from COVID-19;
- Reaching out to all 178 Indigenous communities in our covered territory to understand their concerns and offer support. We assisted over 20 Indigenous communities and support groups by providing PPE, food care packages, digital devices for elders and vulnerable community members, and internet access for students learning from home;
- Accelerating a \$10M investment in our network capabilities to support the increased need for wireless and internet services, including extending wireless high-speed internet to 60 percent more rural customers without access, allowing them to stay home and benefit from remote work, learning, and access to online government services; and
- Deferring all planned pricing increases, extending promotional periods, waiving home internet overages and international wireless roaming charges, delaying hundreds of thousands of suspensions, cancellations and write-offs, and accepting tens of thousands of customised payment arrangements to support those experiencing income disruption.

These examples of successful partnerships indicate how TELUS and the provincial government can combine resources and expertise to deliver the best possible support for the citizens of British Columbia. We look forward to continuing this successful partnership into 2021 and beyond, including working on how we can assist the government in its digital transformation using modern tools and technologies to deliver the services people want and maximizing the power of data to improve the services people need. We request the opportunity to meet at your earliest convenience to discuss future priorities of both TELUS and the Government of B.C. and explore how we can align and support each other in delivering on behalf of British Columbians.

Again, congratulations on your appointment as Deputy Minister to the Premier. On behalf of TELUS, we look forward to continued collaboration and partnership with you and your colleagues in 2021.
