

Subject to an Order in Council being signed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, I am offering you an appointment to the role of Ministerial Advisor in the Office of the Minister for Finance, effective February 16th, 2021. Your supervisor will be Senior Ministerial Advisor, Liam Lawson-Tattersall.

Your salary will be \$86,000 per annum, to be paid in accordance with Salary Range Regulation, B.C. Reg 152/2017.
