General Description of the Incident

At 9:46am on July 8 I received an email from co-located MCFD advising one of their staff was advised by the janitor that he had been unable to set the building alarm for the "past couple of nights". MCFD staff advised that CBRE was contacted for a service request and that it was mark "urgent". At 2:48pm Olson Electric tech arrived to check the security system. The tech could not contact Paladin Security, due to the Rogers problem, to have them interpret the codes on the alarm panel so he could not determine the problem. He advised that he did know that the "sim card" for the security system was from Rogers so he knew that that was part of the problem. The Olson Electric tech left saying that until Rogers had solved their problem, there was nothing more he could do. I advised the janitor that there was no working alarm until further notice so that he didn't spend time trying to find an unsecured window or door when the alarm wouldn't set.
