The investigation of the above application has been completed. Enclosed is a copy of your Conditional Water Licence C131795.

Please read the documents carefully. Any error(s) in these documents should be brought to the attention of this office as soon as possible.

Please note the requirement for an instream flow release of 5% of MAD from both Marionette and Marion 3 Creeks is to remain unchanged with the issuance of this new conditional licence.

The new conditional water licence C131795 is being issued as a supplemental licence to the original licence C115705 to bring the total diversion of the project to 1.4 cubic metres per second.

Please be advised that this supplemental licence C131795 has a 40 year licence term imposed as per Section 12.2(2) of the *Water Act*.

Please note the following:

- Water licences do not authorize entry on privately owned land for the construction of works, or flooding. Permission of the affected landowner must be obtained or an easement expropriated. For your protection, permission should be in writing and registered with the appropriate Land Title Office.
- Permission for installing works on lands or roadways which are under the jurisdiction of any government agency, must be obtained from the agency concerned.

Please contact FrontCounter BC to assist you with notifications and any applications required if:

- a) there is any change in your mailing address;
- b) you sell the land to which the licence is appurtenant;
- c) you propose to subdivide the land to which the licence is appurtenant; or
- d) you propose to alter the works authorized under the licence.

In order for you to keep your water licence in good standing, the following must be observed:

- a) continued beneficial use of water, as authorized under your licence;
- b) payment of annual rentals;
- c) compliance with the terms of your licence; and
- d) compliance with the terms of the Water Act.

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of a lease held under Lands File No.1409836 for the land to which this licence is appurtenant, is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Marionette Creek and Marion #3 Creek.
- b) The points of diversion denoted as PD76153 and PD76895 are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 18, 2014.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (general).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power (general) purpose is 0.4 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which the licence is appurtenant is the land on which the powerhouse is situated, described as District Lot 2179, Clayoquot District held under Lands File No. 1409836.
- h) The authorized works are weirs, penstocks, intakes, powerhouse, tailrace and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is supplementary to Conditional Water Licence C115705 and the maximum quantity of water which may be diverted under this licence is the quantity which together with the quantity available under C131795 will provide a total of 1.4 cubic metres per second.
- k) The licensee is required to release a minimum in-stream flow rate of 5% of the mean annual discharge of each Marionette Creek and Marion #3 Creek.
- 1) The term of this licence is forty (40) years from the date of issuance of this licence.
- m) This licence will remain valid only for so long as a valid tenure exists for the land described in clause (g) herein, or the licensee acquires ownership of the land.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

DECISION DUE DATE: Aug-05-2014

SUMMARY REMARKS

This water application has been made by Marion Creek Hydro Inc. for 0.4m3/sec in addition to the current water licence C115705 for 1.0m3/sec and was made in response to the need to bring the Marion Creek Hydropower Project into compliance based on the actual diversion of water that is taking place during operation.

Since the project was constructed and commissioned for operation in 2005 it has been found that the configuration and type of equipment is actually using up to 0.4m3/sec more than what is currently licenced in order to operate at its maximum potential. The IFR for the diversion reaches are currently set at 5% of MAD which was stipulated in a DFO letter of advice during the projects licencing of C115705 which equates to 0.007m3/sec for Marjonette Creek and 0.019m3/sec from Marjon 3 Creek for a total combined IFR of 0.026m3/sec. This in-stream release will not be affected and will remain unchanged by the issuance of the new licence as the additional volumes of water being applied for are available during high flow events. There is no fish presence within the diversion reach therefore the IFR of 5% MAD is to retain habitat for macroinvertebrate production within this reach.

The Marion Creek Hydro Project is located within the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nation traditional territory and Marion Creek Hydro Inc. has received a letter of support for the project and its need for an additional water licence. The first nation understands that there is no planned changes of the projects facilities and therefore no change to the environmental effects of the project.

There is one downstream licensee from the project on the Kennedy river which is held by DFO. The proponent has notified this licensee and there has been no response to this notification to date. The issuance of an additional water licence of a non consumptive nature on this project will have no effect on flows in relation to this downstream licence.

I recommend to grant a new conditional water licence C131795 for 0.4m3/sec for a power (general) purpose.

Marion Creek Hydro Incorporated currently has a Water Licence (C115705) allowing for the withdrawal of 1.0 m³/s and has requested a new Licence for an additional 0.4 m³/s of water from Marion 3 and Marionette Creeks to reflect the maximum possible use by the powerplant.

The instream flow requirements for the two intakes stipulated in the DFO Letter of Advice for the Marion Creek Project are 5% of mean annual discharge at each intake. As long as 5% of mean annual discharge is maintained at all times for the two creeks, we have few concerns with the requested Water Licence.

- i) The construction of the works authorized under Clause (h) hereof shall not be commenced until design plans, prepared by a professional engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia, have been submitted to, and leave to commence construction given in writing by an engineer under the Water Act.
- j) Prior to commencing the diversion and use of water, the licensee shall submit an operation plan, and must receive in writing from an engineer under the Water Act, leave to commence the diversion and use of water authorized in this licence.
- k) The licensee shall adjust the diversion, rate of diversion, and use of water, as may be ordered by an engineer under the Water Act from time to time, for the preservation of fish and fish habitat.
- The licensee shall measure the flow of water in the stream above the intake, and the
 water diverted from the stream. The licensee shall keep records of such flow
 measurements, and provide a copy of the records to an engineer under the Water Act, at
 his request.
- m) As-built drawings shall be prepared and submitted to an engineer under the Water Act within one year of commencing operation of the works.
- The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water beneficially used, on or before the 31st day of December, 2006.







EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Marion Creek Hydropower Project was built in 2003-2004 and has been in commercial operation since 2005 selling power to BC Hydro under an Energy Purchase Agreement. During project development the maximum withdrawal rate of the facility was underestimated and the project water licence does not reflect current use, though water rental payments have been accurate. Thus, an additional water licence to C115705 is being requested to increase the maximum withdrawal rate from 1.0 m³/s to 1.4 m³/s to cover the maximum possible withdrawal rate for ongoing operations.

The project is 45 km east of Tofino, BC and accessed via Highway 4 and the Marion Creek Forest Service Road. The facility has two intakes: one on Marion #3 Creek and one on Marionette Creek, both tributaries to Marion Creek which flows into Kennedy River on the west coast of Vancouver Island. The secondary intake on Marionette Creek is a Tyrolean weir design with a short plastic penstock leading to the main intake headpond. The main intake is a low head concrete weir with a Coanda intake screen and no active storage. The powerhouse contains a 4.5 MW Pelton turbine-generator and a 190 m long powerline connects the powerhouse to the BC Hydro transmission line along Highway 4.

There are no planned changes in project facilities or operations associated with this water licence application and, thus, no change to the environmental effects of the project. Rainbow trout are only present in the lower 175 m of the 3 km long diversion reach and there are no other overlaps of the project with fish bearing habitat. The project is upstream of the anadromous barrier on Kennedy River and is not accessible to anadromous fish. An instream flow requirement (IFR) of 5% of mean annual discharge is supplied by both intakes to maintain habitat for aquatic macroinvertebrates in the upper diversion reach. In addition to the IFR the large un-regulated catchment area below the intake and upstream of fish-bearing waters mitigates the risk of adverse effects from project operations.

Marion Creek is within the traditional territory of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nation who have provided a letter of support for this application.

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INTRODUCTION

The Marion Creek hydropower facility is a 4.5 MW run-of-the-river independent power project (IPP) located just west of Sutton Pass on Vancouver Island between Port Alberni and Tofino (See Appendix B – Map 1). The project was constructed in 2003-2004 and has been supplying power to the BC Hydro grid since the spring of 2005. The project includes two intakes: one on Marion 3 Creek (an un-gazetted tributary to Marion Creek) and one on Marionette Creek (an un-gazetted tributary to Marion 3 Creek) (See Appendix B – Map 2).

The current water licence for the project (Licence #: C115705) allows the withdrawal of up to 1.0 m³/s for the two intakes combined. This licensed volume was based on preliminary engineering that underestimated the withdrawal rate required for the final design. In the course of operational testing and hydrometric monitoring it has become clear that the project currently withdraws more water than is prescribed by the existing water licence. This application is to obtain a new water licence for an additional 0.4 m³/s. This volume reflects measurement uncertainty and is higher than the estimated maximum withdrawal rate, as described in more detail below. This new licence will bring the facility into compliance with the water licence terms and allows the maximum beneficial use of available water.

An environmental impact assessment was completed during the project permitting phase (Cuthbert 2002a). No changes are proposed to current project operations and no new construction or infrastructure components are involved in the proposed water licence.

1.2 PROJECT DESIGN AND DESCRIPTION

The Marion Creek facility is a typical run-of-the-river hydropower project that has been in operation since 2005. The components of the facility are described below (See Appendix B – Map 2).

Intakes and Headpond

The facility has two intakes. The main intake (PD76153) is on Marion 3 Creek at an elevation of 650 m (49° 14′ 11″ N, 125° 19′ 05″ W). It is a 20 m wide concrete weir with a Coanda screen intake (Figure 1). This intake is located at the base of a large waterfall approximately 230 m downstream of the outlet to Louise Goetting Lake. The instream flow requirement (IFR) is delivered through two circular holes in the intake wall set below the elevation of the spillway over the Coanda screen. The maximum withdrawal rate estimated based on calibration of the tailrace hydrometric station is 1.34 m³/s. This is discussed further in Section 2.3.

As this is a run-of-the river style hydropower facility there is no reservoir associated with the project. A small headpond is formed by the intake weir, There is no active draw-down of the headpond during operations.

There is a secondary intake on a tributary to Marion 3 Creek known as Marionette Creek (PD76895) at an elevation of 655 m ASL (49° 14' 8" N, 125° 19' 03" W). This intake is a Tyrolean weir design with a tapered spillway over a horizontal trash rack (Figure 2). The IFR is delivered through a cluster of holes drilled into the side wall which are covered by a steel screen.




Figure 4. Marionette Creek intake trash rack.

Instream Flow Requirement

The instream flow requirements (IFRs) for the two intakes are stipulated in the DFO Letter of Advice and are 5% of mean annual discharge (MAD) at each intake. Combined MAD at the intakes is 0.52 m³/s (Sjoman 2002). Given the ratio of the drainage areas for the two intakes, the IFR for the Marionette intake should be 0.007 m³/s and the IFR at the main intake should be 0.019 m³/s, for a combined total IFR of 0.026 m³/s (Cuthbert 2002a).

Penstock




Figure 5. Penstock being put in place during construction.

Water diverted from Marionette Creek flows through 80 m of 1 m diameter corrugated plastic pipe and is delivered to the left bank side of the headpond at the main intake (Figure 3). The main penstock is 3,010 m long and 0.66 m (26") in diameter. The lower 995 m of the main penstock is steel, while upper section is ductile iron and HDPE. The penstock is buried in or adjacent to the access road for much of its length (Figure 5).

Powerhouse and Tailrace




Figure 6. Mean monthly power production.

The powerhouse is located on the right bank of Marion Creek at 140 m ASL. It is a 10 m X 14 m concrete block building housing a single horizontal axis Pelton turbine and a 4.5 MW generator. Average monthly power generation for the four years of data is provided in Figure 6 with an average annual average output of 14.2 GWh between 2005 and 2013.

Flows from the powerhouse travel along a rough rock-lined tailrace (Figure 7) which allows gas equilibration to take place before tailrace flows join Marion Creek. The tailrace joins Marion Creek 75 m upstream of the highway and 385 m upstream of the confluence with the Kennedy River. The tailrace is 3 m wide at the base, bedded with gravel and cobble substrate and the banks are rip-rap.

Switchvard and Transmission Line

Adjacent to the powerhouse is a 10 m x 15 m fenced switchyard. A 190 m long 69 kV transmission line connects the switchyard to the BC Hydro 69 kV transmission line between Port Alberni and Tofino/Ucluelet (60L129 GCL-LBH).

1.3 WATERSHED CHARACTERISTICS

The Marion Creek watershed is a west-northwest aspect drainage of the Vancouver Island Mountain Range (See Appendix B – Map 1). Adder Mountain marks the northern limit of the Marion #3 watershed at 1,480 m ASL. The highest elevation in the watershed is 1,520 m ASL in the upper Marion Creek drainage. The confluence with the Kennedy River is at 130 m ASL. The total watershed area is 26.6 km² with 4.4 km² being upstream of the two project intakes.

1.3.1 Watershed Hydrology




Figure 8. Mean monthly discharge for the intakes combined (Sjoman 2002).

Being on the West side of Vancouver Island, the Marion Creek watershed experiences high levels of precipitation throughout much of the year. The upper watershed includes high elevations and is



characterized by a semi-nival hydrological regime with much precipitation falling as snow through the winter months and melting through spring and early summer (Figure 8). In the lower watershed winter storms most often produce high rainfall leading to high flow levels. The low flow period is late summer and early fall when snowmelt is largely exhausted and rainfall is infrequent. During this low-flow season the project is generally shut-down and the stream experiences natural low flow conditions. Mean annual discharge (MAD) for the intakes combined is 0.52 m³/s (Sjoman 2002).

1.3.2 Fisheries

An environmental impact assessment was carried out during the project design and permitting phase (Cuthbert 2002a). Fish sampling in 2001 and 2002 led to the conclusion that fish distribution is restricted to Reach 1 below the 8 m falls (See Appendix A – Map 2). Thus, fish are not present at the intake or in the majority of the diversion reach. The tailrace returns flow to Marion Creek 175 m downstream of the fish distribution barrier on Marion Creek. The barrier to anadromous fish is located in the Kennedy River downstream of the project so there are no salmon in the diversion reach. Low densities of rainbow trout populate the fish-bearing waters of Reach 1.



1.4 LINKAGES WITH OTHER PROJECTS AND ROADS

The Project uses the Marion Creek Forest Service Road (FSR) and Branch MC30 to access the project. All road use permits / agreements are in place for use of these resource roads. There are no linkages with any other projects.

1.5 MARKET FOR ELECTRICITY

All power is sold to BC Hydro under an Energy Purchase Agreement contract.

1.6 SCHEDULE FOR COMPLETION OF PROJECT

The project is constructed and has been operating since 2005.



2 OVERVIEW OF POTENTIAL PROJECT IMPACTS

The following section will outline potential effects of increasing the maximum withdrawal rate from the originally licensed 1.0 m³/s to 1.4 m³/s through the acquisition of a new licence for 0.4 m³/s.

2.1 FIRST NATIONS INVOLVEMENT

Marion Creek is within the traditional territory of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nation. A letter of support has been provided by Tla-o-qui-aht Band Council and can be found in Appendix A.

An archeological overview assessment of the project area was completed during the project design and permitting phase (Archaeo Research 2001, Dewhirst 2002). This assessment concluded that there were no archaeological resources observed and very low potential for archeological resources to be present given the nature of the project area. An environmental management system was developed for the Marion Creek facility following construction (Cuthbert 2002b) which is consistent with the ISO 14001 standard.

2.2 LAND ACCESS

All necessary licences and leases for the use of Crown land and road use permits were acquired for the construction and operation of the project. The powerhouse and transmission line are located in district lot DL 2179, Clayoquot District for which Marion Creek Hydro Inc. hold a lease (Crown File no. 1409836). The intake and penstock are within a Crown Utility Right-of-Way (ROW Plan VIP 82003, Crown File no. 1409890) also held by Marion Creek Hydro Inc.

2.3 PROJECT HYDROLOGY

A hydrological monitoring program has been in place to monitor flow downstream of the intake and flow in the tailrace. Monitoring of diversion reach flows has been in place since the commissioning of the project in 2005. Monitoring flow in the tailrace began in the fall of 2008 with the installation of a stilling well and pressure-transducer datalogger unit recording stage and temperature in 15-minute intervals. The hydrometric station is visited roughly quarterly to download data and measure discharge. The rating curve for this station was fully calibrated on May 26th, 2010 by ramping the plant down from full production (4.5 MW) to close to minimum production (0.5 MW) in 0.5 MW steps and measuring discharge in the tailrace once stage had stabilized. The discharge measured when the plant was at full production was 1.30 m³/s using a Swoffer current meter and 1.17 m³/s using the salt dilution method, with the true maximum use likely falling between these two values. The highest *in-situ* discharge measurement over the entire six year monitoring period calculated a discharge of 1.34 m³/s using a current meter.




Figure 9. Rating curve for the Marion Creek tailrace hydrometric station.

Further analysis of the hydrometric data for this application included the development of a rating curve incorporating all surveyed discharges to date (Figure 9). To assess potential error upper and lower rating curves were fit through the maximum and minimum estimated discharges based on normal expected hydrometric measurement error (5-15% for discharge measurements).

The stage at the hydrometric monitoring station at times rises above the maximum stage recorded during the rating curve calibration procedure. During extreme rainfall events, groundwater inflow may elevate water levels in the tailrace above what is issuing from the powerhouse and explain why the stage is above those recorded during the rating curve calibration exercise. Thus, maximum diversion is estimated to be between 1.17 m³/s and 1.30 m³/s based on the *in-situ* measurements during station calibration.

To ensure that the new water licence brings plant operations into compliance, and allows for possibly running the plant at slightly higher than rated capacity to maximize beneficial use of water, an increase in the maximum withdrawal rate to 1.40 m³/s is being requested.



2.4 FISH AND WILDLIFE

An environmental impact assessment was produced during project permitting (Cuthbert 2002a) detailing potential impacts of the project as designed. As there are no changes to project facilities or operations no changes to wildlife habitat will occur as a result of this new water licence application.

Resident rainbow trout are present in Marion Creek in the lower 175 m of the diversion reach. The intake catchment area represents only 17% of the total watershed area upstream of the upper limit of fish distribution (See Appendix B – Map 1). Thus, the effect of water withdrawals on habitat conditions in the fish-bearing section of the diversion reach were considered to be negligible (Cuthbert 2002). The 5% MAD IFR will continue to support habitat for aquatic invertebrates in the Marionette Creek and Marion #3 Creek portions of the diversion reach. Five years of post-project water quality monitoring did not detect any adverse effects on water quality.



3 CONCLUSIONS

The Marion Creek hydropower facility has been in operation since 2005. Due to an underestimation of the maximum withdrawal rate during initial project development the current water licence is not sufficient to cover current use. To ensure that the new water licence brings plant operations into compliance, and allows for possibly running the plant at slightly higher than rated capacity to maximize beneficial use of water, an increase in the maximum withdrawal rate by 0.40 m³/s is being requested. As there are no fish in the majority of the diversion reach and 22 km² of unregulated watershed area upstream of the upper limit of fish distribution on Marion Creek no change relative to current conditions of project operations on fish habitat is expected.





Based on the information you have provided, we understand that your client, Marion Creek Hydro Inc. is applying to the Province for a new or amended water license for their hydroelectric facility at Marionette Creek (a.k.a. Marion 3), a tributary to Marion Creek. The application is to request an increase to the maximum allowable water diversion, from 1.0 m³/s to 1.4 m³/s. We understand that there are no changes planned to the facility infrastructure or current operations associated with the application.

You have indicated that the same bypass flow / conservation flow will continue to be provided in Marionette Creek at the intake. There are no fish in the upper diversion reach for this facility, and the extent of the diversion reach overlap with fish bearing waters is limited to the deep canyon pool that the tailrace empties into. Given this, and your statement that there is no construction or in-stream work entailed, and not withstanding our Nations Aboriginal Rights and Title within its Traditional Territory, Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations has no objection to the water license application and proposed water use for the duration of the proposed water license.

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE


The holder of a lease on Lands File 1409836 for the land to which this licence is appurtenant, is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Marionette Creek and Marion #3 Creek.
- b) The points of diversion, denoted as PD76153 and PD76895, are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 27th October, 2000.
- The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (general).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1.0 cubic metre per second (35.3 cubic feet per second).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that portion of unsurveyed Crown land lying in the vicinity of Kennedy River and Adder Mountain, within Clayoquot District, held under File 1409836 with Land and Water British Columbia Inc.
- h) The works authorized to be constructed are intakes, penstock, powerhouse, tailrace and transmission lines, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the works authorized under Clause (h) hereof shall not be commenced until design plans, prepared by a professional engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia, have been submitted to, and leave to commence construction given in writing by an engineer under the Water Act.
- j) Prior to commencing the diversion and use of water, the licensee shall submit an operation plan, and must receive in writing from an engineer under the Water Act, leave to commence the diversion and use of water authorized in this licence.
- k) The licensee shall adjust the diversion, rate of diversion, and use of water, as may be ordered by an engineer under the Water Act from time to time, for the preservation of fish and fish habitat.
- The licensee shall measure the flow of water in the stream above the intake, and the water diverted from the stream. The licensee shall keep records of such flow measurements, and provide a copy of the records to an engineer under the Water Act, at his request.
- m) As-built drawings shall be prepared and submitted to an engineer under the Water Act within one year of commencing operation of the works.
- n) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water beneficially used, on or before the 31st day of December, 2006.
