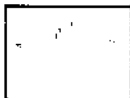


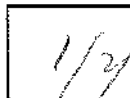

## APPENDIX A CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

### ANGLING GUIDE LICENCE AGNASUWL1277581

1. **For unclassified waters:** on application for renewal of this licence, or April 30, 2013, whichever is earlier, the holder must submit to the Permit & Authorization Service Bureau (PASB) an **Angling Guide Report Form – Unclassified Waters**, located at <http://www.env.gov.bc.ca/pasb/reports> or by contacting PASB. Reports must include all activity between April 1, 2012 – March 31, 2013.
2. **For classified waters:** on application for renewal of this licence, or April 30, 2013, whichever is earlier, the holder must submit to the Permit & Authorization Service Bureau (PASB) an **Angling Guide Report Form – Classified Waters**, located at <http://www.env.gov.bc.ca/pasb/reports> or by contacting PASB. Reports must include all activity between April 1, 2012 – March 31, 2013.
3. The holder must provide to the Permit & Authorization Service Bureau, the names and assistant angling guide licence numbers of each assistant angling guide employed by the holder within 10 days after the start of employment and within 10 days after termination of employment.
4. The holder is restricted to guiding for fish only on those **classified** waters listed in their approved Operating Plan(s), dated April 20, 2010.  
  
The holder is restricted to guiding for fish only on those **unclassified** waters listed in their approved Operating Plan(s), dated April 16<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
5. The holder must carry this licence and approved operating plan when conducting the activities authorized by this licence.

## **APPENDIX B ADVISORY**

### **ANGLING GUIDE LICENCE AGNASUWL1277581**

#### **GENERAL**

- It is the holder's responsibility to be aware of all applicable laws and the limits of this licence. For example, this licence does not give the holder authority to access waters within a Provincial Park without a Park Use Permit.

- If applicable, the holder is responsible for renewing his or her own licence. The Issuer is not obliged to send a reminder notice.

#### **LEGISLATION**

Here are some, but not all, relevant excerpts from the **Wildlife Act**:

##### **Failure to provide information**

- 38** A person who fails, on the request of an officer, to state correctly the locality where and the date on which wildlife or fish in the person's possession was killed, taken or caught by the person or came into his or her possession, commits an offence

##### **Compulsory angling guide licence**

- 49** (1) A person commits an offence if the person acts as a guide for fish, or offers to act as a guide for fish, unless the person

- (a) holds an angling guide licence, or
- (b) holds an assistant angling guide licence.

- (2) A person who holds an angling guide licence commits an offence if the person employs another person to guide for fish and that other person does not hold an assistant angling guide licence.

- (3) An angling guide must

- (a) be present in one of the regions specified in the angling guide's licence, or
  - (b) if specific waters or a specific area is authorized in the angling guide's licence, be present on or near those waters or in that area, in the manner specified on the angling guide's licence
- during substantially all of the times when assistant angling guides employed by the angling guide are guiding for fish.

- (4) If an angling guide fails to comply with subsection (3), a regional manager may take action under section 61.

- (5) An angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the angling guide's licence commits an offence.

- (6) An assistant angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the licence of the angling guide employing the assistant angling guide commits an offence.

##### **Issue of angling guide licences**

- 52** (2) If the holder of an angling guide licence does not observe the undertakings given by the holder in an angling guide operating plan, the regional manager may take action under section 61.

### **Documents not transferable**

**81** Except as authorized by regulation or as otherwise provided under this Act, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization is not transferable, and a person commits an offence if the person

- (a) allows his or her licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization to be used by another person, or
- (b) uses another person's licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization.

### **Failure to pay fine**

**85 (1)** This section applies if a person

- (a) fails to pay, within the time required by law, a fine imposed as a result of the person's conviction for an offence under this Act or the *Firearm Act*, and
- (b) has been served with notice of this section.

(2) In the circumstances referred to in subsection (1),

- (a) the person's right to apply for or obtain a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is suspended immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine,
- (b) all licences, permits and limited entry hunting authorizations issued to that person under this Act are cancelled immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine, and
- (c) the person commits an offence if, before that fine is paid, the person
  - i) applies for, or in any way obtains, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act, or
  - ii) does anything for which a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is required.

### **Production of licence or permit**

**97** If a person who is required to hold a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization issued under this Act

- (a) fails to produce it for inspection to an officer on request, or
- (b) fails or refuses to state his or her name and address to an officer on request,

the person commits an offence.

### **REGULATIONS**

This excerpt from the **Wildlife Act General Regulation**, made under the Wildlife Act, is relevant:

#### **Conditions must be complied with**

**16.01** (e) A person commits an offence where he fails to comply with a condition of or an instruction in an angling licence.

This excerpt from the **Angling and Scientific Collection Regulation**, made under the Wildlife Act, is relevant:

#### **Cancellation, suspension or variation of angler day quota**

**11.2** Subject to section 11.3, a regional manager may cancel, suspend or vary angler day quota held by a person if the person

- (a) fails to use substantially all of his or her angler day quota, without reasonable excuse, or
- (b) contravenes the Act or this regulation.

**LEGISLATION**

Here are some, but not all, relevant excerpts from the **Wildlife Act**:

**Non-use of waters or area by angling guide**

58 If an angling guide does not guide or states that he or she does not intend to guide anglers in a year,

(a) the angling guide may apply to the regional manager for permission to temporarily discontinue or partially discontinue the use of the waters or area authorized by his or her angling guide licence, or

(b) the regional manager may review the angling guide's operation and, after affording him or her an opportunity to be heard, the regional manager may suspend, cancel or refuse to renew the angling guide's licence.

**Failure to pay fine**

85 (1) This section applies if a person

(a) fails to pay, within the time required by law, a fine imposed as a result of the person's conviction for an offence under this Act or the *Firearm Act*, and

(b) has been served with notice of this section.

(2) In the circumstances referred to in subsection (1),

(a) the person's right to apply for or obtain a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is suspended immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine,

(b) all licences, permits and limited entry hunting authorizations issued to that person under this Act are cancelled immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine, and

(c) the person commits an offence if, before that fine is paid, the person

(i) applies for, or in any way obtains, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act, or

(ii) does anything for which a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is required.

Here are some, but not all, relevant excerpts from the **Angling & Scientific Collection Regulation**:

**Qualifications for an angling guide licence**

9 (1) A person who is an angling guide must have public liability insurance, in an amount of not less than \$2 million, that is

(a) applicable to his or her angling guide business, and

(b) in effect during the period for which the angling guide will operate.

(2) A person under 19 years of age is not eligible for an angling guide licence.

(3) An applicant for an angling guide licence or assistant angling guide licence is required to satisfy the regional manager that, with respect to angling in the region where the applicant intends to guide, he or she has a working knowledge of the Act and regulations and the Fisheries Act (Canada) and its regulations.

**Application for an angling guide licence**

10 (1) For each region of the Province in which an applicant for an angling guide licence proposes to guide for fish, the applicant must complete and submit an application in a manner satisfactory to the regional manager

(a) by May 31 where the waters and terms and conditions covered by the application are the same as those in the licence for the preceding year, or

(b) by January 15 where paragraph (a) does not apply.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the regional manager may consider applications submitted after the dates specified in subsection (1) (a) or (b) where the operating plan of the applicant is consistent with the management practices of the water or area and a \$50 payment is received to help defray the cost of processing the late application.

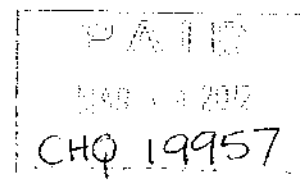

Reports must include all activity between April 1, 2012 – March 31, 2013.

- 38** A person who fails, on the request of an officer, to state correctly the locality where and the date on which wildlife or fish in the person's possession was killed, taken or caught by the person or came into his or her possession, commits an offence

##### **Compulsory angling guide licence**

- 49** (1) A person commits an offence if the person acts as a guide for fish, or offers to act as a guide for fish, unless the person
- (a) holds an angling guide licence, or
  - (b) holds an assistant angling guide licence.
- (2) A person who holds an angling guide licence commits an offence if the person employs another person to guide for fish and that other person does not hold an assistant angling guide licence.
- (3) An angling guide must
- (a) be present in one of the regions specified in the angling guide's licence, or
  - (b) if specific waters or a specific area is authorized in the angling guide's licence, be present on or near those waters or in that area, in the manner specified on the angling guide's licence
- during substantially all of the times when assistant angling guides employed by the angling guide are guiding for fish.
- (4) If an angling guide fails to comply with subsection (3), a regional manager may take action under section 61.
- (5) An angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the angling guide's licence commits an offence.
- (6) An assistant angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the licence of the angling guide employing the assistant angling guide commits an offence.

##### **Issue of angling guide licences**

- 52** (2) If the holder of an angling guide licence does not observe the undertakings given by the holder in an angling guide operating plan, the regional manager may take action under section 61.

### **Documents not transferable**

**81** Except as authorized by regulation or as otherwise provided under this Act, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization is not transferable, and a person commits an offence if the person

- (a) allows his or her licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization to be used by another person, or
- (b) uses another person's licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization.

**85** (1) This section applies if a person

  - ii) does anything for which a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is required.

### **Production of licence or permit**

**97** If a person who is required to hold a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization issued under this Act

- (a) fails to produce it for inspection to an officer on request, or
- (b) fails or refuses to state his or her name and address to an officer on request,

the person commits an offence.



- 49** (1) A person commits an offence if the person acts as a guide for fish, or offers to act as a guide for fish, unless the person

- (a) holds an angling guide licence, or
- (b) holds an assistant angling guide licence.

(2) A person who holds an angling guide licence commits an offence if the person employs another person to guide for fish and that other person does not hold an assistant angling guide licence.

(3) An angling guide must

- (a) be present in one of the regions specified in the angling guide's licence, or
  - (b) if specific waters or a specific area is authorized in the angling guide's licence, be present on or near those waters or in that area, in the manner specified on the angling guide's licence
- during substantially all of the times when assistant angling guides employed by the angling guide are guiding for fish.

(4) If an angling guide fails to comply with subsection (3), a regional manager may take action under section 61.

(5) An angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the angling guide's licence commits an offence.

(6) An assistant angling guide who guides for fish elsewhere than on the waters or in the area authorized by the licence of the angling guide employing the assistant angling guide commits an offence.

##### Issue of angling guide licences

- 52** (2) If the holder of an angling guide licence does not observe the undertakings given by the holder in an angling guide operating plan, the regional manager may take action under section 61.

### Documents not transferable

**81** Except as authorized by regulation or as otherwise provided under this Act, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization is not transferable, and a person commits an offence if the person

- (a) allows his or her licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization to be used by another person, or
- (b) uses another person's licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization.

### Failure to pay fine

**85 (1)** This section applies if a person

- (a) fails to pay, within the time required by law, a fine imposed as a result of the person's conviction for an offence under this Act or the *Firearm Act*, and
- (b) has been served with notice of this section.

(2) In the circumstances referred to in subsection (1),

- (a) the person's right to apply for or obtain a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is suspended immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine,
- (b) all licences, permits and limited entry hunting authorizations issued to that person under this Act are cancelled immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine, and
- (c) the person commits an offence if, before that fine is paid, the person
  - i) applies for, or in any way obtains, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act, or
  - ii) does anything for which a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is required.

### Production of licence or permit

**97** If a person who is required to hold a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization issued under this Act

- (a) fails to produce it for inspection to an officer on request, or
- (b) fails or refuses to state his or her name and address to an officer on request,

the person commits an offence.



##### Non-use of waters or area by angling guide

58 If an angling guide does not guide or states that he or she does not intend to guide anglers in a year,

- (a) the angling guide may apply to the regional manager for permission to temporarily discontinue or partially discontinue the use of the waters or area authorized by his or her angling guide licence, or
- (b) the regional manager may review the angling guide's operation and, after affording him or her an opportunity to be heard, the regional manager may suspend, cancel or refuse to renew the angling guide's licence.

##### Failure to pay fine

86 (1) This section applies if a person

- (a) fails to pay, within the time required by law, a fine imposed as a result of the person's conviction for an offence under this Act or the *Firearm Act*, and
- (b) has been served with notice of this section.

(2) In the circumstances referred to in subsection (1),

- (a) the person's right to apply for or obtain a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is suspended immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine,
- (b) all licences, permits and limited entry hunting authorizations issued to that person under this Act are cancelled immediately and automatically on the failure to pay the fine, and
- (c) the person commits an offence if, before that fine is paid, the person
  - (i) applies for, or in any way obtains, a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act, or
  - (ii) does anything for which a licence, permit or limited entry hunting authorization under this Act is required.

Here are some, but not all, relevant excerpts from the Angling & Scientific Collection Regulation:

##### Qualifications for an angling guide licence

9 (1) A person who is an angling guide must have public liability insurance, in an amount of not less than \$2 million, that is

- (a) applicable to his or her angling guide business, and
- (b) in effect during the period for which the angling guide will operate.

(2) A person under 19 years of age is not eligible for an angling guide licence.

(3) An applicant for an angling guide licence or assistant angling guide licence is required to satisfy the regional manager that, with respect to angling in the region where the applicant intends to guide, he or she has a working knowledge of the Act and regulations and the Fisheries Act (Canada) and its regulations.

##### Application for an angling guide licence

10 (1) For each region of the Province in which an applicant for an angling guide licence proposes to guide for fish, the applicant must complete and submit an application in a manner satisfactory to the regional manager

- (a) by May 31 where the waters and terms and conditions covered by the application are the same as those in the licence for the preceding year, or
- (b) by January 15 where paragraph (a) does not apply.






