Further to our letter dated September 14, 2012, advising Focus Energy Inc. that the deadline to submit the abandonment form was October 12th, 2012, or Water would proceed with the refusal of your application.

Your application has been refused for the following reason:

 You were unable to acquire the necessary Crown Land Lease or Licence of Occupation to establish required tenure to the land for which this application was submitted. As a result, you do not qualify for a water licence under the Water Act.

As per policy there will be no refund issued on your application.

The Water Act gives the recipient of this notice the right to appeal my decision. Notice of any appeal must (1) be in writing; (2) include grounds for the appeal; (3) be directed by registered mail to the Chair, Environmental Appeal Board, PO Box 9425 Stn Prov Govt., V8W 9V1 or personally delivered to the office of the Board at 4th Floor, 747 Fort Street in Victoria, BC V8W 3E9; (4) be delivered within 30 days of receiving this letter, and (5) be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00, payable to the Minister of Finance.

Your application for a waterpower project as described above and accepted on March 8, 2004 has been reviewed in accordance with the new Clean Energy policy.

While we recognize that you have conducted work on the project the current policy requires you to hold an Investigate Licence to ensure that there is ongoing diligent use of the land. All Clean Energy applicants must hold an Investigative Licence which will ensure that investigative activities are being conducted toward the completion and submission of a Development Plan.

A letter was sent to you, dated March 22, 2012 outlining and explaining the requirements for submission of an Investigative Plan in order for us to issue an Investigative Licence, however, to date we have not had a response to our letter and therefore cannot approve your application.

Please be advised that we will be closing our file for this Clean Energy application and will refund 20% of your application fee in accordance with our refund policy. The refund will be sent under separate cover.

Important Notice: This letter describes action that you are required to take in order to avoid disallowance of your Land Act application

You are receiving this letter because Focus Energy Inc. is listed with the British Columba Ministry of Forests, Lands, and Natural Resource Operations (FLNR) as having submitted a Crown Land application for the purposes of developing a waterpower project at Sowerby Creek, Hope. The Land file associated with your application is: 2408585 submitted December 29, 2003.

Currently, FLNR is contacting all waterpower applicants to provide information on recent changes to the Crown Land Waterpower Policy. On August 17, 2011, the Land Use Operational Policy for Waterpower was amended to include the use of a Land Act Section 11 investigative licence. An investigative licence is the form of tenure provided to authorize initial investigation on Crown land and conduct feasibility studies related to the project. The term of an investigative licence is up to five years at the discretion of the Decision Maker with a possibility of a one-time replacement. The policy is available at www.for.gov.bc.ca/Land_Tenures/documents/policies/waterpower.pdf. This policy change is intended to ensure that waterpower applications are being actively pursued by undertaking investigative work.

The policy change to include Land Act investigative licences for waterpower projects was first considered in 2010, in consultation with Clean Energy BC. Prior to that date, there was limited uptake for an investigative tenure under the Waterpower Policy. However, investigative licences have been common in the Windpower and Ocean Energy Policies for some time. The decision to move towards the use of an investigative licence for waterpower was made in order to create a level playing field in BC for all clean energy projects, as well as to improve management of Crown land and resources consistent with FLNR's Crown Land Allocation Policy.

To ensure consistency across the sector, Land Act waterpower applications submitted prior to August 2011 are now being reviewed with the intent to bring pre 2011 applications into alignment with current requirements for waterpower projects on Crown land (i.e. investigative licence). Many pre 2011 applications do not include sufficient information in their original application package to make a determination on issuance of an investigative licence.

Please review the two options on the following page for instructions on how to proceed.

Applicants who do not respond to this letter within 30 days may face disallowance of their application.

OPTION 1: Yes, I wish to pursue my waterpower application

If Focus Energy Inc. intends to proceed with investigations, please provide the following information. Please note that failure to respond within the times indicated below may lead to disallowance of your Land Act application:

- ☐ Within 30 days of receipt of this letter: Respond in writing to Brian Kukulies to confirm your intent to proceed.
- ☐ Within 45 days of receipt of this letter: Submit an Investigative Plan for the application area. (See attachment 1).

When developing an Investigative plan (see attached), please consider the following:

- If an investigative licence is issued, the Investigative Plan will be referenced within the terms of the licence tenure document.
- It is expected that the Proponent will adhere to any commitments or investigative schedules outlined in the Investigative Plan.
- Failure to comply with the Investigative Plan is an event of default that may result in cancellation of the tenure and associated waterpower application.
- Investigative Plans are to be submitted to FLNR, 7077 Duncan Street, Powell River, British Columbia, V8A 1W1, Attention: Brian Kukulies.

OPTION 2: No, I do not wish to pursue my waterpower application

If Focus Energy Inc. does not intend to proceed with investigations, or has otherwise decided not to pursue the project area under application, please contact Brian Kukulies within 30 days to formally withdraw the land application and abandon the water application associated with the proposed project.

Applicants that request a withdrawal of their application within the 30 day timeframe indicated above are entitled to a partial refund of their Land Act and Water Act application fees, in accordance with the fee refund policies for each program area.

Note that this letter serves only as information regarding changes to the Crown land licencing requirements for waterpower projects and in no way implies tenure will be offered nor does it give any authorization to occupy or use the Crown land under application.

- Location, size and main features of project, including proposed access to site;
- Project schedule.

☐ SECTION B: A cadastral plan of an appropriate scale (1:10,000 to 1:20,000) with a north arrow including:

- The exact perimeter boundaries of the Crown Land application area outlined in red, including the dimensions (in metres) and area (in hectares);
- Proposed location of Works, if known;
- The location of intrusive type activities such as drilling, test pitting, etc.;
- Proposed location of transmission line interconnection;
- The proposed water source and tributaries; and
- District lots and major landmarks as reference points.
- Copies of land titles from the <u>Land Title Office</u> for private lands within the application area, and all legal titles and associated legal plans for any survey parcel within and adjacent to the application area. (Note: The licence will be issued for Crown Lands only).
