Dear Chief Rhonda Larrabee,

Re: BC Timber Sales Proposed Operations within your Traditional Territory.

Please find enclosed an information package outlining proposed BC Timber Sales (BCTS) forest operations under <u>Operating Plan (OP) #14</u>, in the Chilliwack Forest District. Included in the package are a set of maps which display planned cutblocks and roads that BCTS is proposing to develop near or within your asserted Traditional Territory (TT).

The purpose of this information package is to inform you of the planned operations and to initiate an information sharing process with you to determine if there are any concerns and/or possible impacts to your Aboriginal interests within the proposed harvest areas. This information sharing approach is consistent with BCTS' Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP) Cultural Heritage Result and/or Strategy. The FSP is an operational plan enabled under the *Forest and Range Practices Act*. The FSP identifies results and/or strategies that address government objectives for a range of forest and resource values, and forms the basis for future development of roads and cut blocks.

To help clarify, there are two (2) types of block/road categories in this package:

- Information sharing blocks and roads: these are newly proposed blocks and roads for development. These areas have not been previously reviewed by a representative in your community and BCTS is seeking your input regarding these areas.
- Previously information shared blocks and roads: these are blocks and roads that
 were previously information shared with your community. BCTS is presenting this
 information to you for completeness only.



Please find enclosed an information package outlining proposed amendment to BC Timber Sales (BCTS) Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP) within the Chilliwack Forest District under <u>Amendment #44</u>.

This package is composed of this information sharing letter and an overview map that outlines the proposed **amendment #44**. The web link shown below contains the proposed amendment document and a series of maps displaying the items required under section 14(3) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* (FPPR). Should there be any challenges in accessing the data at the web link, please contact the undersigned to request a copy of information required.

In accordance with section 21(1) of the FPPR this information package is to inform you of the planned amendment and to initiate an information sharing process with you to determine if there are any concerns and/or possible impacts to your Aboriginal interests by the proposed amendment.

The purpose of the amendment is as follows:

- 1) To include two (2) additional agreement holders' Non Replaceable Forest Licenses (NRFL) held by:
 - a. Matsqui Development Corp. (NRFL A84106)
 - b. Shxw'owhamel Ventures Ltd. (NRFL A91368)
- To adjust the current Forest Development Unit (FDU) boundaries in order to facilitate current and future joint resource management with First Nations and other forest tenure holders.
- 3) To comply with recent legislated requirements to amend the FSP:
 - Incorporate results and strategies to meet the objectives set for a number of recreation trails and a interpretative forest.
 - b. Visual management objectives adjustments in the Chilliwack district.
 - c. Incorporate results and strategies to meet biodiversity objectives set for four (4) landscape units.

The two (2) NRFL holders will only operate within their respective traditional territories and adhere to the prescribed requirements as well as the applicable results or strategies outlined in the BCTS Chinook Business Area's Forest Stewardship Plan within the Chilliwack Forest District.

In accordance with section 20 of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* (FPPR), the FSP amendment is available for public review and comment from **September 5, 2013** to **November 15, 2013**.


Enclosure: (1) FSP Amendment #44 overview map.
