



APPROVAL

Changes in and about a stream

WATER ACT - SECTION 9 (1)

Ministry of Transportation, 441 Columbia Street, Kamloops, B.C. V2C 2T3 is hereby authorized to make changes in and about a stream as follows:

- A. The stream is the North Thompson River.
- B. The changes to be made in and about the stream are construction of a 50 m length of riprap bank protection within the south end of Glenacre Road (McLure) as submitted with application.
- C. All works shall comply to design plans submitted by the Ministry of Transportation for the application.
- D. The works authorized shall be completed on or before April 21, 2007.
- E. All work shall be completed in the "dry".
- F. No silt, or other deleterious substances, shall be allowed to enter the water. This must be ensured through the use of appropriate cofferdam materials.
- G. All work shall be conducted from the top of the bank. No equipment shall be operated in the channel.
- H. All conditions in Tola Coopper's, Department of Fisheries and Oceans Letter of Advice dated April 4, 2007 regarding your proposal must be met.
- I. The holder of this approval shall take reasonable care to avoid damaging any land, works, trees or other property, and shall make full compensation to the owners for any damage or loss resulting from the exercise of the rights granted with this approval.

- J. This approval does not authorize entry onto privately held land.
- K. Vegetation along the North Thompson River shall be disturbed as little as possible.
- L. All excavated material and debris shall be placed in a stable area above the high water mark and protected from erosion by planting grass and/or vegetation.

- M. Any machinery operated on the site shall be in good repair and be free of hydraulic leaks and excess surface oil and grease.
- N. Rock used as riprap shall be clean, durable, angular in shape and suitably graded and sized to resist movement by freshet flows.
- O. Where rock riprap is used to protect against erosion, the streambank must be pulled back to a 2:1 slope (2 horizontal and 1 vertical) before the bank is protected. The riprap shall be placed at a slope no steeper than 2:1, and shall have an entrenched toe/apron of rock placed on the streambed at the toe of the slope. The resulting protected channel must have a cross-sectional area greater than or equal to the present cross-sectional area.
- P. The upstream end of the riprap must be keyed (trenched) back into the bank so that the bank protection is not outflanked by erosion farther upstream.
- Q. Department of Fisheries and Oceans office in Kamloops (851-4950) shall be notified one day prior to commencement of the work.
- R. Prior to carrying out any maintenance of the works under this approval, the holder is to attain the consent of the Regional Water Manager, Southern Interior Region.

The project is a straight forward rip rap placement project that should not require in-stream work. Large diameter rip rap will be placed to the toe of the eroding bank, at the low water mark. The bank does not require re-sloping, just addition of 1m rip rap at a slope of 1.25.1 to a height of ~ 4 m above the low water mark (see typical drawings).				
All work is proposed to take place outside of the water, with rip rap and gravel being imported to the site from the Peterson pit north of Barriere.				
Small woody debris will be incorporated into the rip rap at existing water level to supply fish habitat complexity.
