Re: Proposed Aggregate (sand and gravel) application north of Harrison Mills – File #2409808

I am writing to follow up on your *Land Act* application (File 2409808, Licence of Occupation) for a potential quarrying (sand and gravel) operation north of Harrison Mills and west of the Chehalis River.

As you are aware, the Fraser Valley Regional District Board of Directors refused the Statlu application for a zoning amendment at their Board meeting on February 23, 2016, and followed up with a letter dated April 6, 2016. In addition, ^{s.16} [redacted]

Based on the lack of resolution of the above-noted items, the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations (FLNRO) is unwilling to proceed with our standard application review. Subsequently, this letter is to advise you that we have disallowed the application. As per our Fee Refunds policy, Statlu Resources Inc. is entitled to a refund of 20% of the application fee.

As you have indicated with your July 15th email, if Statlu Resources chooses to revisit this proposal and feels it has made substantial progress towards resolution of the identified issues, FLNRO would be amenable to consider another application for the use of Crown Land.

I understand your interest in still wishing to pursue a potential licence. ^{s.16}

^{s.16} I would definitely suggest you at least initiate discussions with them before making another application.

Also, if the focus of your application is more on its stockpiling capability (smaller area) with the understanding that some soil is required to create a level platform, this may go further as an acceptable use.
