Re: Minor Amendment #5 (Notice of Declared Areas) to the BC Timber Sales Sunshine Coast Operating Area Forest Stewardship Plan (April 1, 2007 - March

31st 2012)

This document constitutes Minor Amendment #5 to the BC Timber Sales Sunshine Coast Operating Area Forest Stewardship Plan (April 1, 2007 – March 31st 2012). The amendment is consistent with Section 20 (Minor amendments to forest stewardship and woodlot licence plans) Forest and Range Practices Act.

The purpose of the amendment is to identify declared areas as defined in Section 14(4) of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation. The attached Table in Appendix 1 identifies 18 areas (timber sales) being declared under this amendment. These timber sales are fully engineered with all required assessments and represent a substantial investment that BCTS is seeking to protect by way of this amendment. The timber sales were prepared in accordance with the approved BCTS Sunshine Coast Operating Area Forest Stewardship Plan – approved April 1, 2007.

Background***

FPRA carries forward the concept of full planning protection where an agreement holder has made stand level investments with the concept of "declared area".

Section 14(4) of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation (FPPR) states:

"A person who prepares and FSP may indentify an area as a declared area if, on the date that the area is identified

• The area is located in a forest development unit (FDU) and is in effect, and

 All of the activities and evaluation that are necessary in relation to inclusion of cut blocks and roads in the area have been completed."

A declared area offers full planning protection to areas within an FDU, which means that these areas are not subject to mandatory amendments under Section 8 of the FRPA. Declared areas are a tool for agreement holders to secure a level of planning protection once an initial investment has been made in an area. This gives an inventory of areas from which the timber sales manager can pick and choose proposed cut-blocks to tender as timber sales, without the risk of change from new government actions. An area having declared status does not have any legal rights beyond the planning protection provisions. Areas that meet the declared area definition may be amended into the FSP, but do not require Delegated Decision-Maker (DDM) approval. Declared areas come into effect on the date the amendment is provided to the DDM.

Applicable Legislation

This amendment is made under section 20(1)(a) of the Forest and Range Practices Act (FPRA). The minor amendment conforms to section 5 of the FPRA and does not materially change the intended results or strategies in the plan. The amendment takes effect on the date the amendment is provided to the District Manager as per section 30(2) of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation. The amendment will be entered in the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resources Operations Forest Stewardship Plan Tracking System as soon as practicable.
