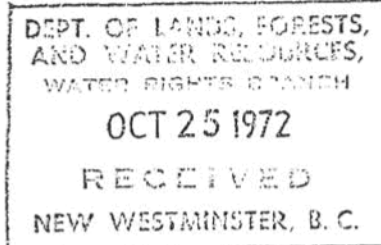

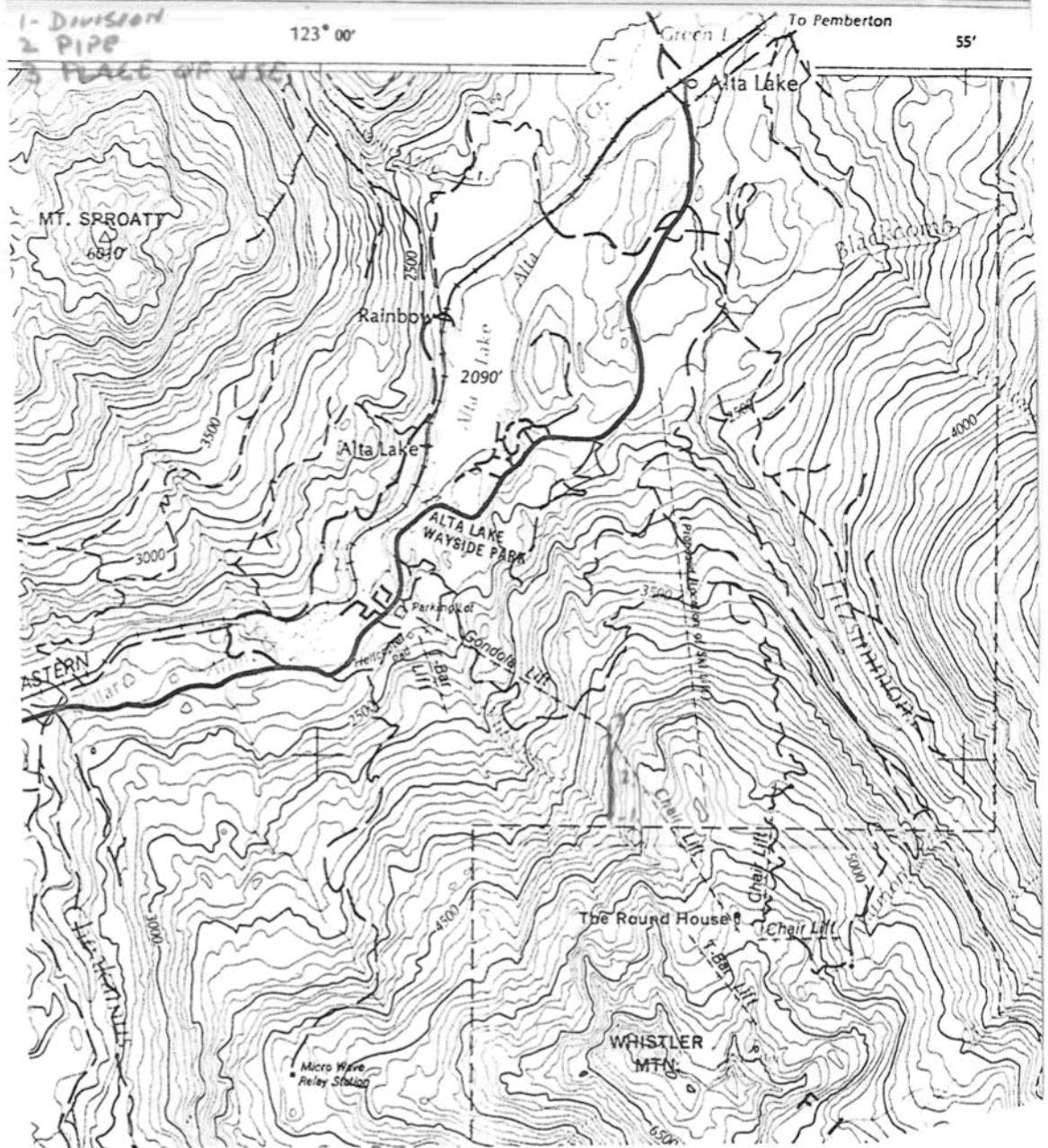

- (2) File two copies with the Water Recorder in whose district the point of diversion will be, within ten days of the posting on the ground.
- (3) Within fifty days of the posting of the application on the ground, serve signed copies on all owners of land or mining property that will be affected physically by the proposed works or by the operation or utilization thereof, and on all licensees or prior applicants whose points of diversion are at or below the applicant's proposed point of diversion.

I have reviewed the letters and the water licences referenced therein.

The *Water Act* does have a clause applicable to the transaction described in the letters provided:

Transfer of licence, approval or permit

16 (1) A licence, approval or permit that is made appurtenant to any land, mine or undertaking and any rights and obligations granted and imposed under the licence, approval or permit pass with a conveyance or other disposition of the land, mine or undertaking.

(2) A person conveying or otherwise disposing of land, a mine or an undertaking to which a licence is appurtenant, or in respect of which an approval or permit was issued or, in the case of a transmission of land, a mine or an undertaking to the personal representative or other person representing the owner, the personal representative or other person must give written notice of the conveyance or other disposition to the comptroller or regional water manager.

As aforementioned, the water rights run with the land and as such, that is good news from your standpoint in that you do not require my signature on the correspondence provided.

What will be needed once the land transaction is completed is formal notification addressed to me, ideally from the previous land owners and the new land owners jointly, that the land conveyance is successfully complete, that there is acknowledgement of the water rights being transferred from one party to the other in relation to the land conveyance and confirmation that the new owner has agreed to take over responsibility for the water licences. Please also clarify at the time of writing any new billing information (i.e. updated addresses and contact people to which bills are to be sent).

Please also provide suitable documentation confirming formal completion of the conveyance. I am not altogether sure of the form of specific document to request at this time because my understanding is there is a Crown land component. If this were say a private land transaction, I would ask to see registration with the Land Titles Office. When Crown land is involved, we seek confirmation that the Crown land tenure has been issued to the new party.

Lastly, amending a water licence does entail a fee payment. Details can be found under the heading "To Amend a Water Licence" on the document entitled "Application Fees"
