





PERMIT UNDER THE WATER ACT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND

The holder of Conditional Water Licences 31190, 33519 and 59777, whose licences authorize the diversion of water from Whistler Creek, are hereby authorized to occupy Crown Land by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said licences.

- (a) The Crown Land which is authorized to be occupied under this permit is a portion of unsurveyed land, Group 1, New Westminster District, lying south of Lot 5316, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licences.
- (b) The approximate area of the Crown Land authorized to be occupied under this permit is 0.34 acre, being 1,000 feet in length and 15 feet in width, for a intake and pipeline.
- c) The permittee may cut and remove from the said Crown Land any timber necessary to permit construction and maintenance of the said works. Prior to the cutting, destruction or flooding of any timber, the permittee shall apply for and obtain a licence to cut timber from the District Manager and the amount of stumpage, royalty and (or) compensation payable to the Crown in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.
- d) This permit is appurtenant to the land, mine or undertaking to which the aforesaid water licences are appurtenant.
- e) This permit shall become void if the water licences with respect to which the permit is issued should terminate, be abandoned or cancelled, or amended so as to render this permit unnecessary.
- f) This permit is issued and accepted on the understanding that the permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Government of the Province of British Columbia for all loss, damage to works, cost or expense suffered by the permittee by reason of the Crown Land or any portion thereof being submerged or damaged by erosion or otherwise affected by flooding.
- g) The holder of this permit shall not be entitled to compensation if the Crown grants permit to other persons to occupy the land affected by this permit.
- h) In the event of a dispute at any time with respect to the area or boundaries of the land affected by this permit, the holder shall, at his own expense, have the said land surveyed by a duly qualified surveyor.
- i) This permit replaces Permit No. 6172 and 14041.

THIS APPLICATION, IF A NEW LICENCE IS ISSUED THE WATERWORKS WILL THEN BE LICENCED FOR 150,000 GPD UNDER C.L. 31190 AND 100,000 GPD UNDER THIS APPLICATION FOR A TOTAL OF 250,000 GPD, WHICH WOULD NOT INCLUDE THE SUPPLY OF WATER TO D.L. 4749, ~~WHISTLER HOUSING~~ WHICH IS NOW OWNED BY WHISTLER HOUSING CORPORATION. D.L. 4749 IS COVERED BY C.L. 30505 FOR 50,000 G.P.D., AND C.L. 23597 FOR 1000 GPD. MR. WALKER SAYS HE IS AGENT FOR WHISTLER HOUSING CORPORATION, AND WILL REQUEST THAT C.L. 30505 BE MADE APPURTENANT TO THE WATERWORKS UTILITY UNDERTAKING, AS STATED IN CLAUSE "g" OF C.L. 31190, SO THAT C.L. 31190, 30505, AND THIS APPLICATION WILL ALL BE APPURTENANT TO THE LAND DESCRIBED IN THE UTILITY CERTIFICATE WHICH WE UNDERSTAND WAS RECENTLY AMENDED TO INCLUDE D.L. 4749. 



- (3) Within fifty days of the posting of the application on the ground, serve signed copies on all owners of land or mining property that will be affected physically by the proposed works or by the operation or utilization thereof, and on all licensees or prior applicants whose points of diversion are at or below the applicant's proposed point of diversion.

All copies must be signed and completed by filling in the blanks in the above form; and, in addition, the two copies filed with the Water Recorder must contain a sketch showing the applicant's land, the location of the point of diversion and the dam (if any), and all land touched or crossed by the works, and the additional information indicated on the other side of this form.

It is advisable to file the application with the Water Recorder as soon as possible after posting it on the ground because the date of filing will, in most cases, determine the priority of the licence that may be issued.
