- The applicant is encouraged to avoid removing beaver dens and/ or beavers during the period of beaver gestation (April-June) and when Kits are present.
- Questions regarding a private property trapping licence and the issuance of such licence should be directed to The Ministry of Forests, Lands & Natural Resource Operations.

The licencee must comply with all applicable federal, provincial, municipal and regional district legislation and by-laws.

It is the responsibility of the licence holder to inform him/herself of all relevant laws.

Failure to comply with any term of this licence is an offence under the Wildlife Act, and may result in prosecution and/or denial of future licence requests.

The licencee agrees by his/her signature on this licence to comply with the terms and conditions of this licence.

The locations listed below do not include any privately owned land for which the licencee does not have the land owner's written permission to trap.
