HI! CBC said they would also ask about reporting requirements and associated costs. (but I think they meant investigations)

The reporting provision in the amendments does not have any impacts on the costs associated with archaeological work. Currently under the HCA, a permit is required to alter any heritage site, which may or may not have associated archaeological costs. Adding a provision to require reporting only increases the Province's knowledge of site locations. The requirement for a permit is necessary for all sites — both known and unknown. In fact, more information about the location of sites allows developers to identify the costs associated with archaeology prior to beginning development, as opposed to incurring the costs mid-development if a site has not been identified previously.

Investigations

Requiring a heritage inspection (or archaeological impact assessment) as a
precondition of a site alteration permit in situations were there is
insufficient information about the heritage value of the property, can
better inform decisions on whether a development should proceed as
proposed. For example, a heritage inspection might find that there is a
significant archaeological site that shouldn't be disturbed, so plans can be
altered earlier, saving time and money.
