

This was my quick interpretation of the announcement for the PO. It can serve as some initial holding messages pending a project plan.

Subject to Vivian's lens on this of course....

Intent of the TSA Process:

- The process announced is about industry competitiveness and community stability
- In principle, the belief is the future of the industry and the communities that depend on it are best mapped and planned by local leadership interests, rights holders and tenured harvesting rights holders who have both a strong understanding of the area, and long-term interest in the area. This is the basis for the TOR and focus of the invites to the tables.
- A strong and collaborative coalition of leadership is best positioned to engage with the provincial government as they understand the local and regional solutions that can lead to industry competitiveness and derive the mutual benefit for rights holders and communities.
- We expect 2-3 TSA's underway by early summer and into the fall

Relationship to Interior Forest Policy Renewal:

- The industry competitiveness and community stability TSA tables will be informed by and will feed into the parallel engagement and policy development process under Renewed Forest Policy initiative that will kick off this spring. Intent is for a broad engagement in the interior communities (being planned) and based on some concept papers on topics such as waste, utilization, bioproducts, adding value, tenure etc...
- The coordination of the timing and the linkage between these processes is deliberate.

Relationship to Land Use Plans and the Modernised Land Use Planning Process

 The forums will obviously be subject to existing land use plans, but expectation is that these strategic engagements could generate change proposals to change existing land use plans in the drive towards local solutions. The modernised Land Use Planning priority projects have been established in BC, however, government will be watchful for forum tables that make significant progress and identify strong competitiveness and community stability opportunities that can be enabled by additional Modernised Land Use Planning investments.

Relationship to proposed Forest and Range Practices Act 2.0 changes under the Renewed Forest Policy initiative:

- The industry competitiveness and community stability TSA tables will enable FRPA 2.0 proposed changes at the local level.
- Development of a TSA level competitiveness vision and affirmation through a strong coalition of local leaders will prepare TSA interests and rights holders for the collaborative Sustainable Forest Management Planning operational planning contemplated by FRPA 2.0. Optimised and efficient collaborative planning of the mid term timber supply is one key outcome at the operational level.
- The sequence of these with FRPA changes is deliberate.
