Dear Chief Councillor Jeff Jones:

The purpose of this letter is to engage the Pacheedaht First Nation in information sharing and consultation regarding BC Timber Sales (BCTS) proposed road building and timber harvesting activities proposed as part of our 2020 Pacific Maritime Operating Plan. The attached table provides a list of blocks being referred and associated information. Please note, blocks referred to in Table 1 also includes any associated road construction within these blocks. The blocks are either shown as *Proposed* status with Pink shapes (blocks being referred for the first time) or as *Previously Referred* status with purple shapes (blocks which have been included in a previous Operating Plan referral). The maps associated with this referral are located on our FTP site and are available for downloading for 7 days after which time they will automatically delete from the site. If you require the mapsheets to be re-loaded into the FTP site don't hesitate to contact BCTS at your convenience. The FTP site is located at the following link; https://www.for.gov.bc.ca/ftp/TSG/external/outgoing/For_Pacheedaht/

This Operating Plan is covered by the BC Timber Sales Pacific Maritime Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP), which was approved with a term commencing on April 1, 2018 and expiring on March 31, 2023. The Cultural Heritage Resources strategy in the Forest Stewardship Plan includes a commitment to refer to the respective First Nations, areas identified for potential timber harvesting, road construction, and foreshore activities, and to consider any information provided respecting cultural heritage resources within the identified areas.

Included in this referral are blocks located within the Pacific TSA portion of Qala; yit Community Forest Agreement (CFA) K5U to address the BCTS reserve volume allocation within the CFA license. BCTS has developed Timber Sale License (TSL) TA0684 Blocks

C070C40F and C060C403 to realize the reserve volume for the first 5 year cut control period. We are anticipating the advertising and award of TSL TA0684 in 2020, however the actual timing will be subject to discussion with the Qala;yit CFA board of directors. Any activities within the CFA will only proceed in accordance with provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding signed between BCTS and Qala:yit.

Other activities that BCTS currently has planned for 2020 within Pacheedaht territory includes the following;

- -the advertising and award of Timber Sale License (TSL) TA0683 Blocks C059C3ZX and C059C40D
- -Block layout of Block C059C4NP in proximity to Parkinson Creek and Highway 14.
- -Planting of Minute Creek TSL A93597 Block C059C4DW (64,400 trees estimated) in fall 2020. BCTS is anticipating providing an Invitation To Quote to Pacheedaht for potential direct award of this work if you are interested.
- BCTS is anticipating a small brushing project in the San Juan Valley to include within a larger brushing contract to be put out for competitive tender. If Pacheedaht is interested in bidding on BCTS brushing work, this contract will be available for viewing on BC Bid when it is put up for tender.

BCTS has also added Parkinson Creek Blocks C058C3HW, C058C4KU, and C058C3HX back on to our 2020 Operating Plan for information purposes. BCTS removed these blocks from our operating plan in 2019 in response to concerns over impact to a potentially affected stakeholder (Soule Creek Lodge), with the caveat that BCTS will await the outcome of the Provincial government's current Old Growth stategic review before proceeding to Decision to readvertise these blocks under a new Timber Sale License. If harvesting of these blocks is consistent with pending recommendations of the Old Growth strategic review, and impacts to Soule Creek Lodge from these blocks are satisfactorily addressed, then BCTS will be including these blocks on our sales schedule in the near future.

The Province recognizes that Pacheedaht First Nation asserts aboriginal rights and/or title (Aboriginal Interests) over the operating area. To better inform our Decisions, we invite Pacheedaht First Nation to provide input on how the proposed activities may impact your Aboriginal Interests and the nature of the impacts of a proposed activity.

In addition to any information that you may provide during this consultation process, the Province will also rely on the following, currently available information;

- Pacheedaht Forest Consultation and Revenue Sharing Agreement signed September 20, 2017
- Pacheedaht First Nation; Review of Ethnographic and Historical Sources
- Archaeological data bases, Archaeological Overview Assessments, Archaeological Impact Assessments.
- Prior consultation and information sharing on Forest Development Plans, Forest Stewardship plans, Operating Plans, and other plans and projects.

As per the current Pacheedaht Forest Consultation and Revenue Sharing Agreement appendix B, consultation on BCTS Timber Sale Licenses and Road Permits is initiated at level 5 (Normal) consultation. However, consultation levels can be adjusted for specific circumstances where

detailed Aboriginal Interest information is shared that would suggest a different consultation level is needed.

BC Timber Sales recognizes that the information available to us is not conclusive or exhaustive; therefore, any additional information regarding Pacheedaht Aboriginal Interests and how they may be impacted by these proposed activities is welcome. We would also appreciate at this time any specific concerns you may have regarding these developments' potential impact on any cultural heritage resources. Your suggestions regarding how to avoid, mitigate or resolve any potential adverse impacts on Pacheedaht Aboriginal Interests would be appreciated.

Specific information regarding proposed timing of planned sales is available in the sales schedule. As the sales schedule is subject to revisions a digital copy of the sales schedule is located on the BC Timber Sales website and will reflect changes in the sales schedule throughout the year. http://www.for.gov.bc.ca/ftp/tsg/external/!publish/sales_schedule/.

I would like to extend an invitation to Pacheedaht to meet with BCTS to discuss our plans and address any questions you may have regarding our proposed operations. As the Timber Sales Manager may proceed to Decision on proposed activities after 60 days, your review and comments regarding this referral by May 7, 2020 would be welcome. This letter is to notify Pacheedaht First Nation that BC Timber Sales (BCTS) is concluding the referral period for the BC Timber Sales 2020 Pacific Maritime Operating Plan, referred to Pacheedaht First Nation on March 5, 2020. The purpose of the referral was to engage in information sharing and consultation with Pacheedaht regarding BC Timber Sales (BCTS) Proposed development activities within Pacheedaht consultative boundaries.

BCTS did not receive a reply from Pacheedaht in response to our 2020 operating plan referral therefore we did not meet to discuss potential impact of BCTS' proposed activities on Pacheedaht interests, however we are available to meet at any time. BCTS activities that have occurred within Pacheedaht territory since the submission of the 2020 operating plan referral includes:

- -the tendering and award of Mosquito Creek TSL TA0683 Blocks C059C40D and C059C3ZX -the tendering and award of Lens Creek TSL TA0684 Blocks C070C40F and C070C403 in partnership with the Qala;yit Community Forest.
- -completion of a small brushing and weeding project under a competitive contract

Other activities BCTS is anticipating within Pacheedaht territory by the end of this fiscal year (March 31, 2021) are as follows;

- Planting of Minute Creek TSL A93597 Block C059C4DW (64,400 trees estimated). BCTS is anticipating the Direct Award of this contract to Pacheedaht.
- -BCTS is planning the advertising and award of TSL TA1377 Block C060C40A in proximity to Allan Creek (net harvest area 39.7 ha., estimated volume 32,000, forest type FdHw second growth).

BCTS would still welcome the opportunity to meet with Pacheedaht representatives at any time to review our current Operating Plans within Pacheedaht consultative boundaries. Dear Chief Councillor Jeff Jones and Council,

The purpose of this letter is to engage with Pacheedaht First Nation in information sharing and consultation regarding the BC Timber Sales (BCTS) 2021 West Coast Forest Operations Map. BCTS, as a program within the Ministry of Forests Lands and Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development (FLNRORD), recognizes that Pacheedaht asserts existing Aboriginal rights and/or title ("Aboriginal Interests") within areas that BCTS operates. The purpose of the consultation is to ensure considerations of Aboriginal Interests are incorporated into the Timber Sale Manager's statutory decision-making for disposition of proposed Timber Sale Licenses or authorization of road construction.

The proposed developments in the operating plan area must be consistent with the BCTS Pacific Maritime Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP), which was approved on March 21, 2018. The *Cultural Heritage Resources* (CHR) strategy in the FSP includes a commitment for BCTS to consult with First Nations on areas identified for potential timber harvesting, road construction, and foreshore activities, and to consider any information provided respecting CHR within the identified areas. The *Forest and Range Practices Act* (FRPA) defines CHR as resources that are the focus of a traditional use by an aboriginal people that is of continuing importance to that people and not regulated under the *Heritage Conservation Act*. As CHR are a subset of Aboriginal rights, they are included in the definition of Aboriginal Interests.

In order to achieve the purpose of the engagement BCTS encourages Pacheedaht to provide any information about Aboriginal Interests, how they may be impacted by the proposed activities in the forest operations map, and any suggestions regarding how BCTS might avoid, mitigate, or resolve any potential adverse impacts.



The tables appended to this letter provide relevant information regarding the cutblocks proposed within the forest operations map, including location, estimated size / volume, stand type / profile, planned sales year, and any comments related to the block. To facilitate your review, the information below provides some additional details on our proposed forest operations map.

<u>Table 1</u> of this letter lists Proposed/New Referral cutblocks on our current block layout plans. We are particularly interested in receiving comments from your Nation concerning this particular selection of proposed cutblocks, as these are the cutblocks we wish to prioritize for survey and resource assessment activities in the coming months.

<u>Table 2</u> of this letter lists cutblocks Previously Referred to your Nation in previous operating plans. If you had requested a block to be walked by members from your Nation, this is the stage where blocks would be walked and work with multiphase contractors is happening to lay out the block.

<u>Table 3</u> of this letter lists the Timber Sale Licenses (TSL's) that BCTS currently has scheduled for advertising in 2021. These blocks have been referred to your Nation in the past and any comments provided would have been integrated into our plans.

<u>Table 4</u> lists road access projects intended for development in the plan area in 2021.

Of note, this referral includes activities being proposed within the Qala; yit Community Forest K5U. The list of Proposed/New Referral blocks in Table 1 includes Blocks OSJodj5BV and OSJosj5BR which are located in the Mount Bolduc chart area of CFA K5U. Qala; yit has proposed these blocks for development by BCTS to meet the next 5 year reserve apportionment for BCTS under the Qala; yit CFA provisions. BCTS is currently reviewing these blocks for viability as a Timber Sale License. Also within the CFA K5U, BCTS is planning to conduct repair work on the Bear Mainline Forest Service Road, as described in Table 4. A deeply embedded wood box culvert over a fish-bearing stream on Bear Mainline is showing signs of failure, therefore BCTS is proposing to permanently remove that structure and re-route Bear Mainline along Lens 6100. The proposed route would reconnect with Bear Mainline past the respective crossing, as shown on the referral mapping.

In addition to any information that may be provided provide during this consultation process, the Province will supplement the following, currently available information to better understand your Aboriginal Interests and how the proposed decision may impact Aboriginal Interests in the area:

- Pacheedaht First Nation Forest and Range Consultation and Revenue Sharing Agreement signed February 17, 2021
- Pacheedaht First Nation; Review of Ethnographic and Historical Sources
