



We understand that bidders to **project # RFP21BC2SHQ016 (Vanderhoof Hangar Development)** were notified on August 3rd that due to changes in government funding and project priorities, the competition has been cancelled and no award will be made.

My assessment of BC Bid indicates that another project **FS22DRM001** was posted on August 26th with a closing date of September 9,2020 – that review further indicates that the scope of work in this revised procurement document is unchanged from the cancelled project. We question the issuance of another RFP that appears to not include any changes to funding, scope, or project priority.

We are familiar with the Reservations of Rights within your bid document and respect an owner's ability to exercise these, however, it appears you are proceeding to another bid process based on the same scope of work and conditions and respectfully request that project FS22DRM001 be placed on **hold pending a response to our concerns.**

NRCA fully supports the BC Government CAMF Guidelines along with best practices that promotes fair, open, and transparent procurement processes, and based on my preliminary review, it appears steps being taken to re-issue another RFP contravenes CAMF.
