Hi Greg. I have attached a schematic about where I think the fence should go. The schematic includes lengths (measured from the GIS/RDOS mapping). Trying to stay well away from the property line except where it comes close to our gate openings down by the dam.

I am hoping you can get a quote and timeline for installation of a four foot (black) chain link. With pedestrian lockable gates above and below the dam. We may want quotes for a higher fence depending on what we hear back from the.22. The fence should intersect with the northern chainlink and at the middle of the existing gate opening through Lot A. We will have to close off the excess opening at that northern opening through the lot A compound.

Remember that we likely won't be able to bring in heavy equipment and may have to hilti some brackets to bedrock below the dam.

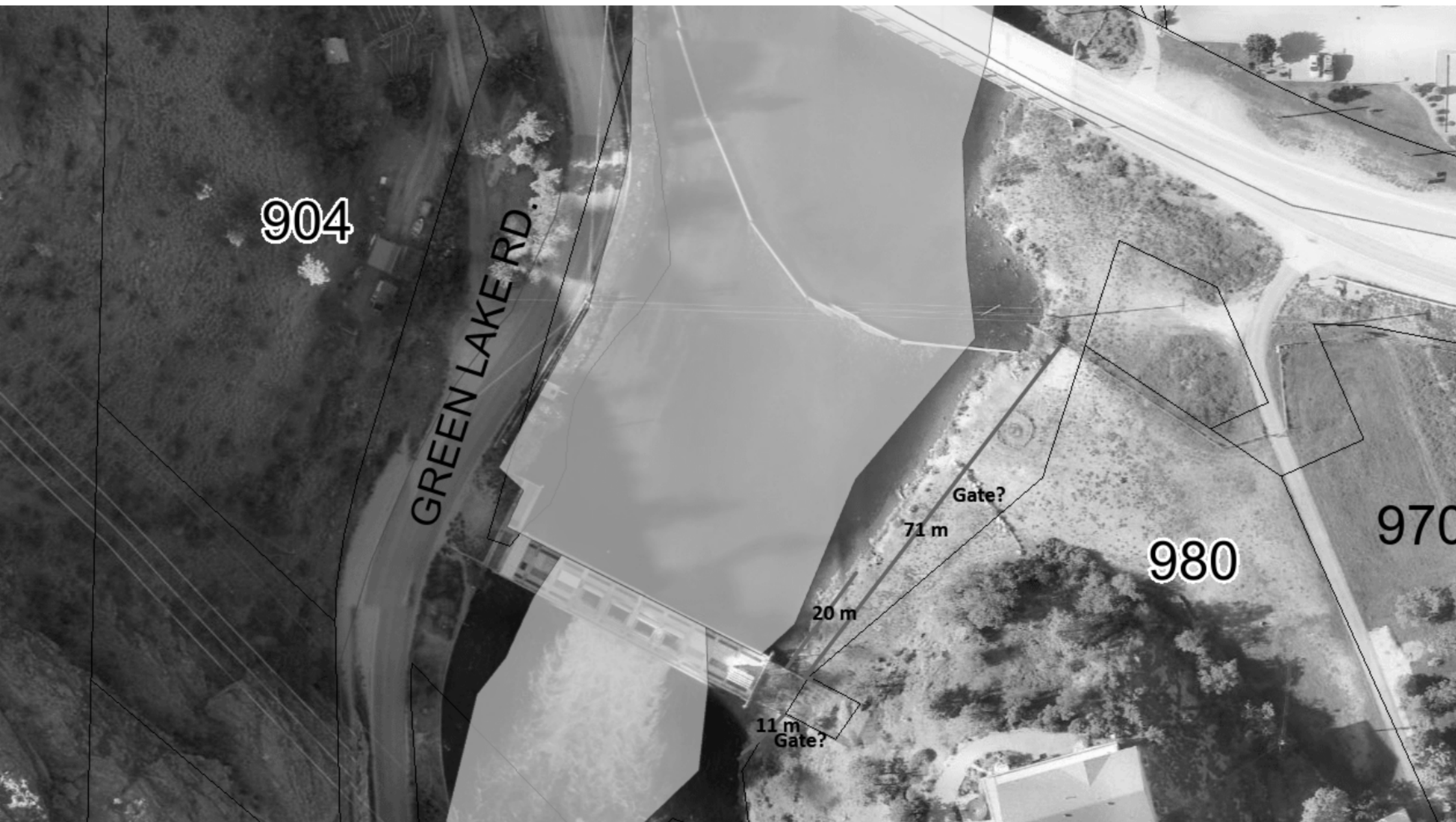
Please emphasize that we are trying to provide a safe corridor prior to fishing season which probably begins in July.

Good afternoon Janis,

Just a quick briefing in regards to a Lands file that Penticton NRO's will be assisting on near the Skaha Lake Dam, Okanagan Falls. Bullet points, below. If more information is needed, please feel free to contact me directly. I don't believe an early warning note is required at this point, but will supply one if anything escalates.

History:

- The ^{s.22}
 - There have been previous involvement with the province and the ^{s.22} in regards to land ownership (Crown vs Private)
- s.16

Current Situation:

- The province has hired a contractor to install a fence (the fence installation will help with public safety near the dam and additionally assist in keeping public off of the ^{s.22} private property)
- The ^{s.22} either believe the fence is being installed on the private property or are against it, as they are interfering with the contractors installation (filling in the post holes).
- The province has had the land surveyed, and the ^{s.22} utilized the Survey General, both declare the property as Crown.

NRO Support:

- NRO HILCHEY and PAUL will be on site with the Contractor at 0700 on Monday July 25.
- If the ^{s.22} attempt to interfere with the installation, we will attempt to educate them on the *Land Act* and the Crown Land verification
- If we cannot generate compliance we will issue a Trespass Notice under the Land Act.
- Failing to get compliance with the TN, we will disengage and engage appropriate support.
