- 1. The name of the stream is Kitkiata River.
- 2. The changes to be made in and about the stream are:
 - i) site preparation as required,
 - ii) placement of abutments and rock fill approaches,
 - iii) two instream piers,
 - iv) construction of a 36.5 metre span bridge as shown on plan submitted by the proponent.
- 3. The land upon which the works are to be constructed is Kitkahta I.R. #1, Range 4, Coast District.
- 4. This approval does not authorize entry onto privately held or Crown land.
- 5. The holder of this approval shall take reasonable care to avoid damaging any land, works, trees, or other property, and shall make full compensation to the owners for any damage or loss resulting from the exercise of the rights granted with this approval.
- 6. Care shall be exercised during all phases of construction to minimize siltation and to prevent debris from entering Kitkiata River.
- 7. Only equipment necessary for the actual installation of the bridge is to traverse the Kitkiata River.
- 8. Where possible, site preparation and construction of the bridge works is to be carried out from the banks of the stream, thus minimizing disturbance to Kitkiata River.
- 9. The minimum span (between the abutments of the bridge) shall be 36.5 metres.
- 10. The bridge abutments shall be adequately protected against erosion.
- 11. Vegetation along the banks of Kitkiata River shall be disturbed as little as possible.
- 12. Instream work shall be undertaken during the period of July 10, 1989 to August 15, 1989.
- 13. The completion date for this approval shall be August 15, 1989.

I will require a finalized agreement to undertake no net loss compensation equivalent to 350 square meters of intertidal marsh, as discussed in the field. Final approval for the Kitkiata River bridge crossing and the Quaal Mainline access will be contingent on signing this agreement.

I look forward to receiving your finalized development plan map showing boundary and road adjustments as discussed in the field. I request that the plans for the proposed bridge crossing on the Quaal mainline (approximately stn 44+00) be submitted with this map.
